Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution Government of India **Standardized Development and Building Regulations, 2023** issued as Special Publication, SP 73: 2023, marks a significant step towards revolutionizing India's built environment. Aligned with the National Building Code of India 2016 (NBC 2016) and incorporating global best practices, these model regulations aim to ensure safety, accessibility, and sustainability in construction across the nation. The document emerges as a beacon of uniformity, designed to streamline structuring and detailing of the development and building regulations of the States/Union Territories, as well as to streamline the building regulatory system across the nation without compromising the specific needs of individual states, union territories and local bodies.

The country is on the path of rapid urbanization and development. Considering the importance of these regulations in ensuring quality and safety of the buildings and related infrastructure, it is important that various stakeholders contributing to building planning, design, construction and operation and maintenance are well aware of the provisions of Standardized Development and Building Regulations, 2023. **Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS)**, being the National Standards Body of the country through its training arm, the **National Institute of Training for Standardized** Development and Building Regulations, 2023 for national capacity building.

#### Learning Objectives

- Enhancing the skills of building professionals, builders/developers and officials working with the town and country planning departments, municipal corporations, municipalities, development authorities, Public works departments and other construction agencies, etc., involved in land development and building construction activities.
- Making participants conversant with the provisions of SP73: 2023 'Standardized Development and Building Regulations' for their copious implementations for safe, sustainable, accessible and orderly development in the country.

#### Who should attend?

 Buildings Professionals such as Architects, Engineers, Town Planners, and officials of Town and Country Planning Departments, Development Authorities, Municipal Corporations, State Housing Boards, State PWDs, and all those concerned with city planning, building regulation, and planning, design, construction and maintenance of buildings and built assets and facilities.
