Item 0 WELCOME & INTRODUCTORY REMARKS

Item 1 CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

In view of no comments, the Committee **CONFIRMED** the minutes of the 21st meeting of the TXD 36 committee held on 27 March, 2023 through CISCO Webex Videoconferencing as circulated vide email dated 06 April 2023.

Item 2 SCOPE AND COMPOSITION OF TXD 36

- **2.1** The Committee REVIEWED the present scope and composition of the Committee TXD 36 as given in **Annex 1** to the agenda and DECIDED as follows:
 - a) Updated Nomination/Fresh nominations to be sought from the following organization:
 - i) Ministry of Textiles (NTTM), New Delhi

Item 3 ISSUES ARISING OUT OF PREVIOUS MEETING OF TXD 36

3.1 The committee noted the summary of actions taken on various decisions of the 21st meeting of TXD 36 as given in **Annex 2** of the agenda.

Item 4 DRAFT STANDARD FOR FINALIZATION

- **4.1** The committee considered the following draft standard as given in **Annex 3** of the agenda:
 - 1) Textiles Determination of Antibacterial Activity of Textile Products [(First revision of IS/ISO 20743) (Doc : TXD 36 (22151)]

After deliberations, the committee decided that the above draft standard as given in agenda is **FINALIZED** for publication as Indian Standard. BIS may carry out the editorial changes in the finalized draft, if required.

Item 5 DRAFT AMENDMENT FOR WIDE CIRCULATION

5.1 IS 19022: 2023, Medical Textiles — Barrier Face Covering — Specification

The committee considered the comments/suggestion received from CMD-II and SITRA as given in **Annex 4** and **Annex 5** respectively in the agenda.

The committee also considered the proposed amendment 1 to IS 19022 : 2023 as given in **Annex 6** of the agenda.

After deliberations, the committee decided that the following changes shall be incorporated in in amendment 1 to IS 19022: 2023 [Doc: TXD 36 (22649)]:-

(*Page* 2, *Clause* 6, *second line*) — Substitute the following for the existing:

'Reusable barrier face coverings shall withstand at least 5 washing and drying cycles when tested using reference washing machine Type A (wash procedure no. 4 N, 40 ± 3 °C) or using reference washing machine Type B (wash procedure 4B, 41 ± 3 °C) using reference detergent 2 and drying procedure (as per care instruction) as specified in IS 15370.'

(Page 2, Clause 8 third line) — Substitute the following for the existing: -

'The laces, elastic strips, fabric tie etc. used as fastening mechanism shall withstand a minimum force of 10 N (for single use face covering) or 50 N (for reusable face covering) when subjected to a tensile force for 10s with the face covering mounted on a dummy head. The schematic diagram for reference is provided as follows:




FIG. 1 SCHEMATIC DIAGRAM FOR TIE AND ATTACHMENT STRENGTH TEST (FOR GUIDANCE ONLY)

[Page 3, Clause 7.1, Table 1, Sl no (iv)] — Insert the following note at the end:

'NOTE — 'Reusable barrier face coverings shall withstand at least 5 washing and drying cycles when tested using reference washing machine Type A (wash procedure no. 4 N, 40 ± 3 °C) or using reference washing machine Type B (wash procedure 4B, 41 ± 3 °C) using reference detergent 2 and drying procedure (as per care instruction) as specified in IS 15370.'

[Page 6, Clause 9.1, Table 2, Sl no (i), Annex B] — Substitute 'FIG. 2' for 'FIG 1.'

[Page 6, Clause 9.1, Table 2, Sl no (i), **B-2**] — Substitute the following for the existing:

'Suitable breathing resistance test apparatus for measurement of pressure differential equipped with flow meter, pressure gauges etc. (such as the apparatus given in Fig. 2).

NOTE —Equivalent automated instruments validated against the test method prescribed may also be used.'

[Page 7, Clause 9.1, Table 2, Sl no (ii), Annex C] — Substitute 'polystyrene latex' for 'latex'.

[Page 7, Clause 9.1, Table 2, Sl no (ii), C-1] — Insert the following note at the end:

'NOTE — Instead of aerosol containing suspended polystyrene latex (PSL) spheres, NaCl aerosol may also be used.'

[Page 7, Clause 9.1, Table 2, Sl no (ii), C-2] — Insert the following note at the end:

'NOTE — Equivalent automated instruments validated against the test method prescribed may also be used.'

[Page 3, Clause 9.1, Table 2, Sl no (iii)] — Delete.

The committee further decided that the matter is urgent and the wide circulation of the above amendment be waived off under Rule 22 (4) of BIS Rules 2018 notified vide GSR 584(E) dated

25 June 2018; and draft amendment 1 to IS 19022 : 2023 be held to have been **FINALIZED** for publication. BIS may carry out the necessary editorial changes in the finalized draft, if required.

5.2 IS 17354: 2020, Medical Textiles — Dental Bib / Napkins — Specification

The committee considered the suggestion received from SITRA on suitable liquid for testing of dental bib as given in **Annex 7.**

After deliberation, the committee decided that an amendment incorporating following changes shall be issued:-

- i) [(Page 1, Table 1, Sl no. (iv), a)] Substitute 'Liquid absorbency time' for 'Sinking time'.
- ii) [(Page 1, Table 1, Sl no. (iv), b)] Substitute 'Liquid absorptive capacity' for 'water holding capacity'.
- iii) The informative annex on test liquid for dental bib is to be included and the inputs are to be suggested by SITRA.
- iv) (Page 2, Clause 7.1) Insert the following information at the end:f) Declared shelf-life of the product

The draft amendment so prepared may be issued in **wide circulation** for **2 months** for eliciting technical comments from stakeholders. BIS may carry out the editorial changes in the draft if required.

Item 6 PRELIMINARY DRAFT FOR APPROVAL FOR WIDE CIRCULATION 6.1 Medical Textiles – Nonwoven Gauze (Sterile and Non-Sterile) - Specification

The committee considered the performance table for non-woven gauze swab and the test report received from M/s Ginni filament as given in **Annex 8** of the agenda.

After deliberation, the committee decided that the performance requirement as given in the following table shall be included in the existing draft (as given in 21st meeting agenda): -

After deliberation, the committee requested the following member to share the additional inputs on scope, raw material/fabric, workmanship and finish, performance requirement, sampling, packing and marking on the above subjects:-

Item 8 COMMENTS ON PUBLISHED STANDARDS

8.1 IS 5405 : 2019, Sanitary Napkins — Specification (Second Revision) and IS 17514 : 2021, Reusable Sanitary Pad / Sanitary Napkin / Period Panties — Specification

The committee considered the working draft for test method for determination of volatile organic compounds along with comments received from SGS, Chennai as given in **Annex 10** and **Annex 11** of the agenda respectively.

After deliberation, the committee decided that the development of test method for determination of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) shall be taken up with Chemical Methods of Test Sectional Committee, TXD 05 on top priority. Once the test method of VOCs is developed by TXD 05, then the chemical compound/substances, frequency and requirement of VOC test may be deliberated in TXD 36 for needful action in IS 5405: 2019 and IS 17514: 2021.

8.2 IS 17334 : 2019, Medical Textiles — Surgical Gowns and Surgical Drapes — Specification

The committee considered the agenda and minutes of panel meeting held on 18 May 2023 as given in **Annex 12** of the agenda.

After deliberation, the committee decided that the recommendation of panel meetings dated 24 November 2022 and 18 May 2023 shall be incorporated in the revised draft of IS 17334.

The committee further decided that the following aspects/comments shall be discussed in next meeting of TXD 36:-

- i) The remaining comments of SITRA on test procedure and reporting of (Hydrostatic resistance test, Particle release test and Biocompatibility test), requirement of dry and wet microbial penetration.
- ii) Any other aspects.

Item 9 INTERNATIONAL ACTIVITIES

9.1 The committee noted the information given in the agenda item. It was also requested to TXD 36 members/nominated experts to participate and share their views on working documents/agenda items for working group meeting of Adhoc Group/Task Group/WGs under ISO/TC 338.

9.2 Committee Internal Ballot (CIB) - ISO TC 338 N 38 Menstrual Products — Terminology

The committee considered the Committee Internal Ballot (CIB) - ISO TC 338 N 38 Menstrual Products — Terminology as given in **Annex 17** of the agenda.

After deliberation, the committee requested TXD 36 members/nominated experts to go through the document and share their suggestion/comments latest by **31 July 2023**.

Item 10 REVIEW OF PUBLISHED STANDARDS

10.1 The committee considered the standards due for review and pre-2000 standards as given in the agenda.

After deliberation, the committee decided to reaffirm the following Indian Standards for further period of 5 years: -

- 1) IS 16111: 2013, Elastic bandage
- 2) IS 6237: 1971, Specification for handloom cotton cloth for plaster of Paris bandages and cut bandages
- 3) IS 757: 1971, Specification for handloom cotton lint, absorbent, bleached, non-sterilized (first revision)

The committee requested Shri T. Balaji, KOB Medical Textiles and Dr. Manish Sabharwal, Dr. Sabharwal Wound Care, Baddi to review the requirement of GSM, Stretch Length and Extensibility due to wider range in the draft standard of IS 16111: 2013, Elastic bandage as given in the agenda and provide their comments within 15 days.

The committee further decided that BIS shall prepare the draft revision of above standards based on review performa and comments received from stakeholders. The draft revision so prepared shall be issued in wide circulation for **2 months** for eliciting technical comments from stakeholders. BIS may carry out the editorial changes in the draft if required.

The committee also decided that following Indian Standards shall be reviewed by expert members for their comments and suggestion: -
