Resolution 01/2023

ISO/TC 157 resolves to request an extension of time for ISO/CD 4074 – Natural rubber latex male condoms due to the significant nature of the changes that have been proposed. Subsequently, the committee manager will fill up the Project Limit Date Extension Form and submit to ISO/CS.

Establishment of a sub group under the ISO/TC 157/WG 20, Clinical trials

ISO/TC 157 resolves to establish two sub groups under the ISO/TC 157/WG 20, Clinical trial to perform the preliminary works for the revision of ISO 29943-1:2017- Condoms – Guidance on clinical studies – Part 1: Male condoms, clinical function studies based on self-reports, and ISO 29943-2:2017 - Condoms – Guidance on clinical studies – Part 2: Female condoms, clinical function studies based on self-reports. The other sub group will perform the preliminary work for the revision of ISO 11249:2018 Copper-bearing intrauterine contraceptive devices – Guidance on the design, execution, analysis and interpretation of clinical studies.

A call for members/ experts of the two sub groups will be launched by the Committee Manager and all members are welcomed to nominate their experts through their respective National Standards Body (NSB). The scope and TOR of the two sub groups shall be established once they are formed officially.
