#### Item 0 WELCOME & INTRODUCTORY REMARKS

**0.1** Shri Vishesh Nautiyal, Chairman TXD 08 welcomed the members present in the meeting and appreciated their contribution in the Standards formulation activity in the area of Handloom and Khadi.

**0.2** Shri Swapnil, Member Secretary TXD 08 also welcomed the Chairman and members present during the meeting.

#### Item 1 CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

**1.1** The committee **CONFIRMED** the minutes of the 18<sup>th</sup> meeting of the committee held on 29 November 2023 through VC as circulated vide BIS letter No. TXD 08/A2.18 dated 10 December 2023 without any changes.

#### Item 2 SCOPE AND COMPOSITION OF TXD 08

- **2.1** The Committee **REVIEWED** the present scope and composition of the Committee as given in **Annex 1** to the agenda and **DECIDED** as follows:
- i) Shri Vishesh Nautiyal, Chairperson of TXD 08, would help in getting the fresh nominations from Center of Excellence for Khadi (COEK)-NIFT, New Delhi.
- ii) Dr. M Sundar, The Handloom Export Promotion Council, Chennai would help in getting the fresh nominations from Department of Handlooms & Textiles, Chennai.
- iii) Fresh nomination to be obtained from IIHT, Varanasi.
- iv) The Committee decided to co-opt the following organizations in TXD 08 Sectional Committee:
  - a) IIHT, Salem;
  - b) IIT, Delhi;

- c) Flag Foundation of India, New Delhi; and
- d) KVIC, Mumbai.

#### Item 3 ISSUES ARISING OUT OF THE PREVIOUS MEETINGS

**3.1** The Committee **NOTED** the summary of actions taken on the various decisions of the previous meetings of TXD 08 as given in **Annex 2** to the agenda and decided as follows:

#### For item 3.1: Regarding Standard for Polyester Fabric Flag:

- a) The committee noted that no inputs have been received from M/s Khadi Dyers and printers, Mumbai and Dr. Thennarasu P of Indian Institute of Handloom Technology, Varanasi on Indian National Flag made of Polyester.
- b) After deliberation the committee decided that M/s Khadi Dyers and printers, Mumbai shall send the 5 samples of National Flag made of Polyester to BIS and Dr. Thennarasu P of Indian Institute of Handloom Technology, Salem.
- c) After detailed deliberation, the committee decided that Dr. Bipin Kumar, IIT, Delhi and Shri Ashim Kohli, Flag Foundation of India, New Delhi would provide the inputs on Indian National Flag made of Polyester to BIS.
- d) After deliberation the committee further decided that M/s Khadi Dyers and printers, Mumbai and Dr. Thennarasu P of Indian Institute of Handloom Technology, Salem shall provide the required inputs on National Flag made of Polyester within 15 days.
- e) Further, after detailed deliberations the committee decided that based on inputs received, working/ preliminary draft on Polyester Fabric Flag shall be prepared which shall be circulated to committee members for 15 days for eliciting technical comments and working/ preliminary draft along with comments shall be discussed in next meeting.

# **4.1.1** After detailed deliberations the committee decided as follows:

a) For standards at Sl No. 1, 3, 4, 5, 11, 13, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21 and 22, the committee decided to **FINALIZE** the WC drafts for publication without any changes.

b) For standards at Sl No. 2, 9, the committee decided to **FINALIZE** the WC draft for publication with the following changes:

[*Page* 21 and 63, *Clause* 6.4] — Under the column 3 & 4 i.e. No. of Test & Criterion for Conformity respectively for Sl No. (i) erroneously mentioned as Col (2) & (3). Similarly, in Sl. No (2) under No. of Test Column written as Col (4). It shall be Col (3) and Col (4) for No. of Test & Criterion for Conformity as per Table 3 for Sl No (i). Similarly for Sl No (ii) under No. of Tests shall be Col (5).

c) For standards at Sl No. 12, the committee decided to **FINALIZE** the WC draft for publication with the following changes:

[Page 83, Clause 4.2, Table 2, Sl No. iv] — Change the requirement of pH value of aqueous extract from 6 or 8.5 to 6 to 8.5.

[*Page* 84, *Clause* 6.4] — Under the column 3 & 4 i.e. No. of Test & Criterion for Conformity respectively for Sl No. (i) erroneously mentioned as Col (2) & (3). Similarly, in Sl. No (2) under No. of Test Column written as Col (4). It shall be Col (3) and Col (4) for No. of Test & Criterion for Conformity as per Table 3 for Sl No (i). Similarly for Sl No (ii) under No. of Tests shall be Col (5).

d) For standards at Sl No. 15, the committee decided to **FINALIZE** the WC draft for publication with the following changes:

[Page 103, Table 2] — To include the requirement of pH Value of aqueous extract in between 5 to 7.5 as per IS 1390.

[*Page* 104, *Clause* 5.4] — Under No. of Tests column mentioned as According to co1 2 of Table 3 and according to co1 4 of Table 3. Column 2 is for Lot size not a sample size and Column 4 is for Permissible No. of Non-Conforming Blankets. Under Criterion for Conformity, column 3 is for sample size. It shall be Col 3 of Table 3 in No. of Tests. Under Criterion for Conformity, column shall be 4. Under No. of tests in second row, it shall be column 5.

e) For standards at Sl No. 6, the committee decided to **FINALIZE** the WC draft for publication with the following change:

[Page 44, Table 2] — To include the requirement of pH Value of aqueous extract in between 6 to 8.5 as per IS 1390.

f) For standards at Sl No. 7, the committee decided to **FINALIZE** the WC draft for publication with the following change:

[Page 50, Table 2] — To include the requirement of pH Value of aqueous extract in between 6 to 8.5 as per IS 1390.

g) For standards at Sl No. 10, the committee decided to **FINALIZE** the WC draft for publication with the following change:

[Page 68, Table 2] — To include the requirement of pH Value of aqueous extract in between 6 to 8.5 as per IS 1390.

h) For standards at Sl No. 14, the committee decided to **FINALIZE** the WC draft for publication with the following change:

[Page 96, Table 2] — To include the requirement of pH Value of aqueous extract in between 6 to 8.5 as per IS 1390.

j) For standard at Sl No. 8, the committee decided to **FINALIZE** the WC draft for publication with the following change:

[Page 56, Table 2] — Insert the following note at the end:

Nature of coating and percentage of coating shall be as agreed between buyer and seller.

k) For standard at Sl No. 23, the committee decided to **FINALIZE** the WC draft for publication with the following changes:

[Page 164, Annex C] — Substitute the following for existing:

Cut a sample of fabric measuring 30 cm  $\times$  30 cm and bring it to moisture equilibrium by conditioning in standard atmospheric conditions of 67 percent  $\pm$  2 percent RH and 27 °C  $\pm$  2 °C temperature (*see* IS 6359). Mark a square of 25 cm  $\times$  25 cm on the sample. Make four reference points on each side of the square at 5 cm intervals so that by including the sides of the square, six determinations can be made in warp and weft direction. Make two slits of 1.25 cm from opposite edges of the fabric and pass a rod through the slits. Mount the sample in the ventilated oven by means of the rod so that air circulates freely around the sides of the sample. Bring the oven to a temperature of 160 °C  $\pm$  4 °C before the sample is inserted into the oven and the sample shall remain in the oven for 16 seconds. Then withdraw the sample and remove it from the rod, lay in on a flat smooth surface and allow it to cool. Measure the distance between each pair of marks to the nearest millimeter and record the change in the dimensions. Determine the average of the readings in the warp and weft directions separately and express it as a percentage of the original length.

BIS may carry out any editorial changes in the above drafts, if required.

#### Item 5 COMMENTS ON PUBLISHED INDIAN STANDARDS

**5.1** The Committee scrutinized the comments received from Shri Manoj Kumar, on IS 745: 2021 'Textiles — Handloom Cotton Bed Sheets — Specification (*fourth revision*)' and IS 854: 2021 'Textiles — Handloom Cotton Turkish, Honeycomb and Huckaback Towels and Towelling Cloth — Specification (*third revision*)'. After detailed deliberations the committee decided to drop the comments as given in **Annex 5** to the agenda.

**5.2** The Committee scrutinized the comments received from Manak Manthan organized by BIS Guwahati Branch Office on 04 May 2024, on IS 752: 2023 'Textiles — Handloom Cotton Muslin, Bleached — Specification', IS 755: 2023 'Textiles — Handloom Cotton Malmal — Specification' and IS 8039: 2023 'Textiles — Handloom Cotton Mix Saris — Specification'. After detailed deliberations the committee decided to drop the comments as mentioned at Sl No. (a), (c), (e), and (g) in **Annex 6** to the agenda.

After detailed deliberations the committee also decided to issue amendments for standards IS 8039 : 2023 and IS 752 : 2023 after incorporating the following changes:

a) For IS 8039 : 2023, [Page 1, Clause 4.1.1] — Substitute the following for existing:

The yarn shall be either filament or spun made from viscose rayon, modal, or tencel.

[Page 2, Table 2, Sl No. iv] — Change the requirement of colour fastness to Light (for dyed fabrics only) from 5 or better to 4 or better.

[*Page 3, Clause 7.4*] — Substitute the following for existing:

b) For IS 752: 2023, [Page 1, Clause 5.3] — Replace "fuel" with "feel" in the third line.

[*Page* 3, *Clause* 7.5] — Substitute the following for existing:
