ITEM 13 ANY OTHER BUSINESS

- 13.1 Creation of standardization cells for providing inputs and co-ordination during the process of development of Standards. Establishing Standard clubs in Educational Institutions.
- 13.2 Organizing Outreach webinars/seminars for dissemination of standards related work in the Siddha field and Ayush in general as well to create awareness regarding already published Indian standards.
- 13.3 Annual Research Projects for conducting Research on requirements of Standards, National Relevance and Economic importance of Products. Guidelines shared along with Agenda.
- 13.4 Each of the member of a Technical Committee shall be required to sign a declaration concerning the duties and responsibilities of the member of a Technical Committee in the form prescribed by BIS.
- 13.5 It shall be mandatory for a member of the Technical committee to record his comments in regard to a preliminary Draft Standard. In case, a member feels that the subject the draft deals with is not related to his domain knowledge, he should have it mentioned in his comment.
- 13.6 Absence from two consecutive and less than 50 percent of the meetings of the TC held in a year shall invite termination of the membership except in special circumstances acknowledged in the writing by the Divisional Council on the basis of the recommendation of the TC to this effect.
- 13.7 A person whose membership is terminated on the ground of absence from the meetings or not responding to the preliminary Draft standard shall not be eligible to be re inducted as a member in any of the TCs of BIS for two years from the date of termination.
- 13.8 BIS will also encourage the TC members to write books/reference materials on Indian standards by providing financial or logistical support, as approved by the committee constituted for this purpose.
- 13.9 BIS will also encourage the TC members to collaborate with the institutions BIS has MoU with, to organize workshops, seminars or guest lectures on Indian Standards.
- 13.10 BIS encourages conducting Industry Meetings to understand the requirements for Standardization in sector as well as prospects of international trade and commerce in the field.
- 13.11 The committee may discuss any other item related to standardization in the field of Siddha, with the permission of the chair.

General Comments:

Comment 1:

The document is nicely drafted and almost all aspects of crude drug are covered. However, the reviewer is in opinion that the crude drug specifications should have chemistry component as well. To ensure the quality of any plant based crude drug or formulations, in addition to the existing specifications, chemical quality of the drug must be ensured. The crude drug from Zingiber officinale must contain at least few biomarkers from zinger like gingerols, 6-gingerol, 10—gingerol, zingerone etc. duly characterized by well accepted method of chemical analysis and the level of one or two biomarkers or their chemical class may be defined. The level of biomarkers can be specified in ranges or not less than some defined level.

As suggested by Ministry of Ayush, the monograph has been drafted by harmonizing the pharmacopeia of Ayurveda, Siddha and Unani system of medicine. Any addition in the pharmacopeia will be included in subsequent revisions of this Indian standard.

Comment 2:

Thank you very much for your email. I have gone through the document and found that it is well prepared. However, there are some small additions required for the quality assurance/ quality check of raw material as well as extract and formulations. These points are given as below

- 1. Type of solvents for required of extraction/extract preparation should be defined.
- 2. The limit residual solvents like halogenated and non-halogenated in the formulation/extract should be defined.
- 3. Quality assurance of raw herb, extract and formulation should be on the basis of characteristic chemical marker compounds with consideration of minimum four and at least one should be defined as the bioactive marker on the basis of biological activity data.
- 4. The limit of chemical markers that will be used for quality assurance should be defined as not less than/more than (NLT/NMT).
- 5. The limit of chemical markers should be defined on the basis of well recognized techniques.

As suggested by Ministry of Ayush, the monograph has been drafted by harmonizing the pharmacopeia of Ayurveda, Siddha and Unani system of medicine. Any addition in the pharmacopeia will be included in subsequent revisions of this Indian standard.
