Escola Superior de Educação de Lisboa (ESELX)



ESELX has a cafeteria (offering full meals at the special price of 4 euros per person to our Delegates and Experts) and two coffee shops, one with a balcony facing the gardens.

The ESELX location is very convenient: it is 8km from the Lisbon airport. Public transportation (regional train, metro, and bus) is within walking distance of ESELX (5-10 minutes), connecting to all parts of Lisbon, including downtown, for those who prefer to stay in more touristic areas. Also within walking distance (5-10 minutes), there are two shopping malls, shopping streets, coffee shops and restaurants.
