6.4. India is a Participating member in ISO/IEC/JTC 1 SC 17 and ISO/IEC/JTC 1/SC 31. As P member, India has an obligation to vote and send response/comment on the documents emanating from the committees. Participating Countries can also nominate their experts on the working Group to participate in international standardization activities. The ballots currently active have been listed in [ANNEX 7](#).
