Item 0 WELCOME & OPENING REMARKS BY THE CHAIRPERSON

5.1 Process Reforms in Formulation of Standards

The Member Secretary provided the committee with a comprehensive update on the various process reforms initiated by BIS and encouraged the committee to adhere to the guidelines and suggestions for enhancing our operations.

5.1.1 Annual Action Plan for the year 2024-25

Annual Programme for Standardisation for 2024-2025 as given in the agenda was approved by the committee.

To undertake revision of IS 15086 (Part 5): 2020, the committee decided that data regarding issues faced and failures encountered will be collected by a group of 3 members –

- i) Shri Ankit Saboo (Elektrolites (Power) Private Limited, Jaipur)
- ii) Shri Pramod Tupe (Tata Power Limited, Mumbai)
- iii) Shri Chetan Kumar Bhurat (Orange Power Transmission & Distribution Equipments Private Limited, Bangalore)

The group will submit the data by **15-06-2024**.

The committee also decided that revision of IS 15086 (Part 8): 2017 with adoption of IEC 60099-8:2017 is to be carried out.

5.2 Latest structural and process reforms

The Member Secretary apprised the committee of the reforms as mentioned in the agenda, with particular focus on the Efficiency Index which has been devised for assessment of Sectional Committees.

- 7.1 Member Secretary explained the new "Guidelines for Research & Development Projects for Formulation and Review of Standards," stating that all committees are encouraged to adopt a research-based approach in standard formulation and propose as many research projects as possible. The aim is to create well-defined research documents to support the committee's decision-making. Moreover, since most of these small research projects will be awarded to academic institutions that have signed an MoU with BIS, it would create awareness among colleges regarding standards.
- 7.2 Member Secretary requested members to recommend subjects for R&D pertaining to the formulation of standards based on the committee's scope.
