2.2 Instructions for the Effective Implementation of the Process Reforms Aimed at the Strengthening of the Standardization Ecosystem in the Country

As per instruction received from DG BIS, absence from two consecutive and less than 50 percent of the meetings of the TC held in a year shall invite termination of the membership except in special circumstances acknowledged in the writing by the Divisional Council on the basis of the recommendation of the TC to this effect. A person whose membership is terminated on the ground of absence from the meetings or not responding to the Preliminary Draft standard shall not be eligible to be re-inducted as a member in any of the TCs of BIS for two years from the date of termination.

Further, performance of members shall be evaluated based on their contribution to the P-drafts (comments), drafting of Working drafts, comments on ISO ballots, attendance in the meetings, active participation in deliberation in the meetings etc.

- b) The next step will be to designate one or two members of the SC to represent BIS in respect of the standards of the Level H (High) and M(Medium). The designated experts will be the face and voice of BIS for that project at the ISO/IEC level.
- c) The designated expert shall have the responsibilities of sharing detailed comments on the Drafts/documents received from ISO/IEC, helping the SC in putting together the rationale for proposing NWIPs and firming up proposals for leadership positions and secretariats and briefing the SC on the deliberations at ISO/EC level.

It may be noted that ISO 7465 has now been revised as “ISO 8100-33:2022 Lifts for the transport of persons and goods: Part 33 T-type guide rails for lift cars and counterweights”.
