## ITEM 6 INTERNATIONAL ACTIVITIES

6.1 A proposal to establish an ISO Technical Committee (TC) dedicated to Ayurveda and Yoga has been submitted to ISO. Following an internal review process, the proposal has been revised in response to feedback and resubmitted to the ISO Central Secretariat.

6.2 The BIS proposal on Ayurveda and Yoga was discussed during 91<sup>st</sup> Technical Management Board Meeting held on September 10, 2024 at Caratgena Colombia.

6.3 TMB has in principle decided to allocate BIS proposal to ISO/TC 249; to amend the title of ISO/TC 249 to "Traditional Medicine" and to create an SC on Traditional Chinese Medicine and another SC on Ayurveda and Yoga, if the proposal is approved during the ISO Members consultation. TMB has, therefore, decided to circulate the proposal on Ayurveda and Yoga to all ISO Members to determine the level of engagement in this field of work.
