Comments/Suggestions along with Justification for the Proposed Change			<p>We request a revision of the scope of IS 302 (Part 2/ Sec 9), which currently covers toasters, grills, roasters, and similar household appliances. This standard addresses common hazards associated with these appliances that may be encountered by individuals in and around the home.</p> <p>Scope NOTE 103 mentions the exclusion of specific electrical appliances but does not specifically exclude hot plates and ovens, which are intended for use in research laboratories and industrial settings.</p> <p>Similar electrical appliances used in industry and research laboratories share the same HSN code and descriptions as regulated ovens and hot plates. Consequently, these appliances fall under the purview of BIS compulsory registration during customs clearance, leading to varying interpretations by enforcing authorities.</p> <p>IS 302, intended for electrical appliances such as stationary storage-type electric water heaters (e.g., IS 302 (Part 2/Sec 21)), specifically excludes appliances meant exclusively for industrial purposes.</p> <p>Therefore, we request an amendment to IS 302 (Part 2/Sec 9): "Safety of household and similar electrical appliances - particular requirements - Toasters, Grills, Roasters and Similar Appliances." This amendment should include the exclusion of hot plates, ovens, and other electrical appliances intended exclusively for industrial purposes and research laboratory use.</p> <p>NOTE 103 — This standard does not apply to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a) stationary ovens and stationary grills (IS 302-2-6);b) warming plates (IS 302-2-12);c) frying pans and deep fat fryers (IS 302-2-13);d) microwave ovens (IS 302-2-25);e) barbecues for outdoor use (Indian Standard not available);f) appliances intended for commercial catering; andg) appliances intended to be used in locations where special conditions prevail, such as the presence of a corrosive or explosive atmosphere (dust, vapour or gas).	

Proposed Change/Modified Wordings

the section Note 103 of the IS std should be revised to include exclusion of the similar appliance use in research laboratory & industry as follows

NOTE 103 — This standard does not apply to:

- a) stationary ovens and stationary grills (IS 302-2-6);
- b) warming plates (IS 302-2-12);
- c) frying pans and deep fat fryers (IS 302-2-13);
- d) microwave ovens (IS 302-2-25);
- e) barbecues for outdoor use (Indian Standard not available);
- f) appliances intended for commercial catering; and
- g) appliances intended to be used in locations where special conditions prevail, such as the presence of a corrosive or explosive atmosphere (dust, vapour or gas).
- i) appliances intended for reserach laboratory & industry**
