ITEM 0 GENERAL

0.1 Welcome by BIS

Dr. G. Kiruthiga, Member Secretary of the Siddha Sectional Committee, welcomed the Chairperson and all the participating members of AYD-05 to the fourth meeting of the Siddha Sectional Committee. She expressed gratitude to them for sparing their valuable time to support the Ayush Department at BIS in its standardization efforts. Dr. Kiruthiga briefed the members on the ongoing activities since the last meeting and encouraged all members to attend meetings regularly and provide valuable feedback on all drafts, especially the P Drafts circulated by BIS. She extended thanks to the Chairperson for her constant support and acknowledged the active panel members for their efforts in preparing P drafts.

0.2 Opening Remarks by Chairperson, Siddha Sectional Committee (AYD-05)

Prof Dr. R. Meenakumari, Chairperson of AYD-05, extended a warm welcome to all the members of the Siddha Sectional Committee and the representatives of the BIS Secretariat. She urged the committee members to actively engage in the development of Indian standards for Siddha medicine, emphasizing the current opportunity for stakeholders in Siddha medicine to benefit from the establishment of robust Indian standards in this field. She also emphasized the potential for these Siddha Standards to be elevated to the ISO level in the future. She commended the efforts of the various working groups of BIS highlighting the vision of the Secretary, Ministry of Ayush, in



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advancing the development of Indian standards to strengthen Siddha system at both national and international levels. Prof Dr.R.Meenakumari commended active involvement of BIS in standardization work covering all domains of the Ayush system through the Working Groups, Panels and Technical committees. Furthermore, she urged the technical committee members to contribute actively and effectively to the development of Indian Standards for Siddha medicine by providing valuable comments and technical inputs to improve drafts at each stage within a specified timeframe.

Thereafter, item-wise discussions of the Agenda were taken up.

ITEM 1 CONFIRMATION AND MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

In the absence of any comments, the committee confirmed the minutes of the Third (3rd) Siddha Sectional Committee (AYD-05) meeting held on March 14th, 2024, which were circulated to the committee members.

The Committee expressed significant concern about the potential delay in completing the P-drafts and urged the working groups to submit the remaining drafts within a period of one month.

ITEM 7 NEW SUBJECTS

As part of the deliberations, the Committee suggested taking up important Siddha subjects such as *Chunnam*, *Muppu*, *Theeneer*, *Kattu*, *Kalangu*, *Kuzhambu*, and *Pooneeru* for the development of Indian Standards. This will provide deeper insights into Siddha at both the Indian and international levels. The committee has agreed to address these new subjects in the upcoming meetings.

ITEM 8 TECHNICAL ISSUES

The committee noted that there are no specific technical issues to be discussed and decided upon.

ITEM 9 PROGRAMME OF WORK

The committee noted the programme of work for AYD -05.
