**ITEM 0 GENERAL**

**0.1 Welcome**

Dr. Kumar Vivekanand, Member Secretary of the Homoeopathy Sectional Committee, welcomed the Chairperson and all the members of AYD-07 present during the meeting.

**0.2 Opening Remarks by the Chairperson, AYD 7**

Dr. Raj K. Manchanda, Chairperson, AYD-07, welcomed the members of the Homoeopathy Sectional Committee and encouraged the virtual participants to attend next meetings physically for a more interactive discussion. He shared his experience during a visit to Shanghai University of Traditional Chinese Medicine, where a dedicated working group has been formed to explore the standardization of Homeopathy. Homoeopathy is one of several areas of focus, alongside Ayurveda, Unani, Nutraceuticals, Herbal Medicines and others. The university is open to adopting Homoeopathy, provided that Indian Standards are established. They have set up a specialized infrastructure equipped with advanced technology to support the standardization process and aim to elevate this work to the ISO level. This presents a significant opportunity for collaboration in both the industrial and educational sectors in the coming years. Consequently, the standardization work being undertaken by BIS is of crucial importance in this context.

Dr Rajesh Shah, Dr Bhar, Dr S Kartik Raghavmurthy (Bahola Labs), Dr Prakash Joshi, Dr Priyanka Motwani and others may be included as the members (see Item 6, Annex B).

## ITEM 8 TECHNICAL ISSUES

8.1 The Committee noted the directions of DG, BIS for actively participating in BIS meetings and using the BIS portal for the standard formulation process.

8.2 The Committee deliberated and agreed for the R&D project related to the Development of quality parameters of fast-moving drugs and their mother tinctures (Hydro alcoholic extract) especially 44 identified drugs and suggested that Terms of Reference to be modified accordingly.
