1. Opening of the meeting and IEC code of conduct

Chair and Secretary opened the 15th Plenary meeting of IEC SyC AAL at 9:00am and welcomed the delegates and liaison representatives. Delegates were informed about the IEC Code of Conduct for technical work.

6. Report from the AG1 - Chair's Advisory Group

Chair provided an overview of the activities of IEC SyC AAL, summarized the progress, and thanked everyone for the work done in the past. Mr Dejun Ma reported on the 2 previous meetings of the Chair's advisory group that took place in February and June 2024, respectively. Chair also introduced the Invitation to JWG on "Embodied IoT Systems" to be established by IEC/JTC1/SC41 discussed in AG1 meeting presented by Ms Catherine Grant.

Decision 03: Committee acknowledged report of AG 1 – *Chair's advisory group*. Committee approved proposal from the Chair to ask the Secretary to circulate Q document to establish Joint WG with JTC1 SC41, to call for a convener and expert(s) to P-members of the committee on "Embodied IoT Systems".

7. Report from WGs and MTs

7.1. Report from WG1

The Convenor of WG 1, Mr. Hirokazu Tanaka, provided a report on the work of WG1 and the latest meetings. He recommended that the Plenary approve circulation of the Q document if a PWI on "Collaboration between AAL users and AAL systems" is to be established.

Decision 04: Committee acknowledged report of WG 1 - *User Focus*. Committee approved to circulate Q document if PWI on “Collaboration between AAL users and AAL systems” shall be established.

7.2. Progress report of WG 2

Ms Janina Laurila-Dürsch presented the report of WG 2. The CC observation of CDV of IEC 63240-1 ed2 was resolved and will be sent to secretariat for distribution.

Decision 05: Committee acknowledged report of WG 2 - *Architecture and Interoperability*. Committee approved that the revision project IEC 63240-1 ED2 - *Active assisted living (AAL) reference architecture and architecture model - Part 1: Reference architecture*, advances to its publication.

7.3. Progress report of WG 3

Mr. Anthony Ciccarello provided a report on the work of WG 3. IEC SRD 63408 was published in April 2024. WG3 recommended that the Plenary circulate the Q document to establish a PWI on "Roadmap for AAL system development and standards mapping". Secretary will contact the SyC AAL liaisons and request that they review the standards inventory and identify standards to be added.

Decision 06: Committee acknowledged report of WG 3 - *General specifications, Quality and Conformity assessment*. Committee congratulated the publication of IEC SRD 63473 ED1 - *Active assisted living (AAL) use case standards inventory and mapping* in April 2024. Committee approved to circulate Q document to establish PWI on “Roadmap for AAL system development and standards mapping.”

7.4. Progress report of WG 4

Mr Dejun Ma reported on behalf of WG 4. The group is working on the IEC SRD 63314 ED1 - *AAL requirements for education and training of persons working in the field of AAL*. The DTS of IEC SRD 63314 ed1 has been approved. The comments received on SyCAAL/340e/DTS were discussed and the CC observation was resolved. WG4 recommends proceeding with IEC 63314 to the next stage - the publication stage, and requests that IEC 63314 submit the revised CC document.

7.5. Progress report from WG 5

Ms. Taehwa Han provided a report on behalf of WG 5. WG5 reviewed the results of the CDV (SyCAAL/331/CDV) and discussed and resolved comments based on the CDV results. WG5 agreed that the project (IEC 63310 ED1) should proceed to the next stage (FDIS), mindful of the project timeline.

Regarding the PNW (Guidance for AAL Services based on smart speakers in the connected home environment) proposed at the previous Seoul meeting, WG5 reviewed the comment results of the SyCAAL/345/Q for PWI registration and resolved the comments. Based on the results of SyCAAL/345/Q and meeting discussion, WG5 agreed to register the PWI and prepare the NWIP with an expiry date of 2025-03-31.

Decision 08: Committee acknowledged report of WG 5 - *AAL in the connected home environment*. Committee approved advancement of the IEC 63310 ED1 - *Functional performance criteria for robots used in AAL connected home environment*, to approval stage (FDIS), following final review of the document by WG 5 members prior to the submission of the document to IEC Secretariat. Committee approved extension of expiry date on newly approved PWI on “Guidance for AAL services based on smart speakers in the CHE” to 2025-03-31.

7.6. Progress report from MT6

Ms Janina Laurila-Dürsch provided a report on behalf of MT 6. MT 6 discussed Result of Questionnaire (SyCAAL/346/Q “Questionnaire on the approval on new and modified terms”) and made decision on the two comments received.

7.7. Progress report from WG7

Mr. Atsushi Miyoshi provided a report on behalf of WG 7. WG 7 discussed the conclusion from its previous meeting to change IEC 63168 from IS to SRD. However, the members of WG 7 were unable to reach a consensus on how to advance this project. The Convenor of WG7 will arrange a web call as soon as possible. The committee encouraged WG7 to deliver the RNP and CD document of IEC 63168.
