Subject: Amendment No. 1 to Guidelines for Good Practices on Exposure Visits

issued on 13 May 2022

Based on the experiences gained and on the basis of inputs received from ROs/BOs, the Guidelines for Good Practices on Exposure Visits issued on 13 May 2022 is amended as follows for removing the constraints in providing exposure visit to students from far flung schools:

Substitute the following for existing clause 5. vi. b):

Depending upon the group for the exposure visit, BIS Office/Lab to identify additional locations for exposure visits such as BIS Licensees, BIS Lab/Recognized Lab, or Science Museums, Science Parks, and similar facilities if industrial units or labs are not available.

Substitute the following for existing clause 5. vi. c):

Wherever exposure visits are planned for areas in close proximity, half-day each for Office and Industry/Lab visit could be adequate, if the exposure visit has to involve both. However, in cases where exposure visit is being organized for Schools in far flung areas, it may be required to arrange for travel and stay of students resulting in an increase in duration of visit by one day. For such outstation visits, BOs may arrange for the travel & stay for the students, as applicable to BIS employees, Level 6 or actual, whichever is less.
