Subject: Minutes of the meeting chaired by Cabinet Secretary at 03:00 PM on 28th April, 2023 on Mission Lifestyle for Environment (LiFE)

A meeting was held under the chairmanship of Cabinet Secretary regarding activities to be undertaken in the run up to the World Environment Day on 5th June, 2023. The list of participants is annexed.

- 2. Secretary, MoEFCC recalled that a CoS meeting on the subject of Mission LiFE was held in November 2022, wherein Ministries had been asked to organise activities for advocacy and awareness about Mission LiFE. She made a detailed presentation highlighting the key activities undertaken so far, like the Print and Electronic Media campaigns, workshops, marathons, nature camps, etc. It was mentioned that LiFE has been included in the cover decision of COP-27, which is known as 'Sharm Al Sheikh Implementation Plan'. A reference to the need for a transition to sustainable lifestyles and sustainable consumption and production patterns has also been made in the Joint Communique of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO).
- 3. Secretary, MoEF&CC presented the key activities proposed to be undertaken by the Ministry during the months of May and June. It was mentioned that the Ministry proposes to organize 1 lakh events through the Forest Department and its own Organizations before the World Environment Day. These include Bicycle Rallies, Pond Cleaning, Plastic Waste Collection, e-Waste Collection Drive and such other activities. The Ministry also envisages involvement of youth in spreading the message of LiFE by organizing a Youth Conclave through the Indian Institute of Forest Management, along with sensitizing school going children and others about LiFE. She informed that the Ministry is working on developing a portal 'Meri LiFE' which would have a mobile interface and would capture the awareness generation activities of Ministries as well as of individuals.
- 4. A suggested Plan of Action with respect to various Ministries / Departments, as a run up to the World Environment Day, was thereafter presented. Representatives of various Ministries informed about the activities/ initiatives already being undertaken for implementation of LiFE and their strategy for mass mobilization through various activities in May and June this year.
- After discussions, the following decisions were taken:-
 - (i) Activities listed out by MoEFCC are illustrative and the Ministries may suitably add more activities and draw up detailed action plans. Emphasis should be on utilizing the network of institutions at the grassroots level for creating awareness about the Mission and inculcating the sustainable consumption behaviour.

Substantive activities may be initiated based on the underlying concept of Mission LiFE. These Action plans may be shared with MoEFCC.

- (ii) Ministries may hold meetings with their own field organizations and their counterpart departments in the State Government in order to ensure mass mobilization for the LiFE event being organized by MoEFCC on World Environment Day on 5th June.
- (iii) Ministries may ensure that all activities are under the broad theme and logo of Mission LiFE. Daily report of all awareness generation and LiFE events being undertaken is to be uploaded on the portal merilife.org. Ministries / Departments to nominate a Nodal officer for this purpose.
- (iv) Ministries to utilize their own social media handles facebook, Twitter, Instagram etc. and to post creatives and activities to generate maximum reach through social media. The social media creatives and videos could be downloaded from the LiFE portal, where they are available in open format.
- (v) Sensitization and awareness activities in colleges may also be undertaken along with various activities planned in schools for dissemination of LiFE messages. Rural Development Ministry may also be involved in the advocacy and awareness campaign to leverage their outreach in rural areas through 'Self Help Groups'.
- (vi) A framework for collection and re-cycling of all waste, especially e-waste to be put in place by MoEFCC in collaboration with MietY and MoHUA.
- (vii) Ministries concerned to include, in their LiFE Actions, the issue of creating awareness about preventing food wastage and taking appropriate action in coordination with Industrial/ Hotel Associations.
- (viii) CPSEs to be also involved by the respective Ministries/ Departments, to undertake awareness generation and mass mobilization campaigns regarding Mission LiFE.

The meeting ended with a Vote of Thanks to the Chair.



Meeting Pad/Office Copy 24 copies Subject: Minutes of the meeting chaired by Cabinet Secretary at 03:00 PM on 28th April, 2023 on Mission Lifestyle for Environment (LiFE)

A meeting was held under the chairmanship of Cabinet Secretary regarding activities to be undertaken in the run up to the World Environment Day on 5th June, 2023. The list of participants is annexed.

- 2. Secretary, MoEFCC recalled that a CoS meeting on the subject of Mission LiFE was held in November 2022, wherein Ministries had been asked to organise activities for advocacy and awareness about Mission LiFE. She made a detailed presentation highlighting the key activities undertaken so far, like the Print and Electronic Media campaigns, workshops, marathons, nature camps, etc. It was mentioned that LiFE has been included in the cover decision of COP-27, which is known as 'Sharm Al Sheikh Implementation Plan'. A reference to the need for a transition to sustainable lifestyles and sustainable consumption and production patterns has also been made in the Joint Communique of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO).
- 3. Secretary, MoEF&CC presented the key activities proposed to be undertaken by the Ministry during the months of May and June. It was mentioned that the Ministry proposes to organize 1 lakh events through the Forest Department and its own Organizations before the World Environment Day. These include Bicycle Rallies, Pond Cleaning, Plastic Waste Collection, e-Waste Collection Drive and such other activities. The Ministry also envisages involvement of youth in spreading the message of LiFE by organizing a Youth Conclave through the Indian Institute of Forest Management, along with sensitizing school going children and others about LiFE. She informed that the Ministry is working on developing a portal 'Meri LiFE' which would have a mobile interface and would capture the awareness generation activities of Ministries as well as of individuals.
- 4. A suggested Plan of Action with respect to various Ministries / Departments, as a run up to the World Environment Day, was thereafter presented. Representatives of various Ministries informed about the activities/ initiatives already being undertaken for implementation of LiFE and their strategy for mass mobilization through various activities in May and June this year.
- After discussions, the following decisions were taken:-
 - (i) Activities listed out by MoEFCC are illustrative and the Ministries may suitably add more activities and draw up detailed action plans. Emphasis should be on utilizing the network of institutions at the grassroots level for creating awareness about the Mission and inculcating the sustainable consumption behaviour.

Substantive activities may be initiated based on the underlying concept of Mission LiFE. These Action plans may be shared with MoEFCC.

- (ii) Ministries may hold meetings with their own field organizations and their counterpart departments in the State Government in order to ensure mass mobilization for the LiFE event being organized by MoEFCC on World Environment Day on 5th June.
- (iii) Ministries may ensure that all activities are under the broad theme and logo of Mission LiFE. Daily report of all awareness generation and LiFE events being undertaken is to be uploaded on the portal merilife.org. Ministries / Departments to nominate a Nodal officer for this purpose.
- (iv) Ministries to utilize their own social media handles facebook, Twitter, Instagram etc. and to post creatives and activities to generate maximum reach through social media. The social media creatives and videos could be downloaded from the LiFE portal, where they are available in open format.
- (v) Sensitization and awareness activities in colleges may also be undertaken along with various activities planned in schools for dissemination of LiFE messages. Rural Development Ministry may also be involved in the advocacy and awareness campaign to leverage their outreach in rural areas through 'Self Help Groups'.
- (vi) A framework for collection and re-cycling of all waste, especially e-waste to be put in place by MoEFCC in collaboration with MietY and MoHUA.
- (vii) Ministries concerned to include, in their LiFE Actions, the issue of creating awareness about preventing food wastage and taking appropriate action in coordination with Industrial/ Hotel Associations.
- (viii) CPSEs to be also involved by the respective Ministries/ Departments, to undertake awareness generation and mass mobilization campaigns regarding Mission LiFE.

The meeting ended with a Vote of Thanks to the Chair.

Minutes of the Meeting held under the Chairmanship of DG Forests regarding coordination activities for World Environment Day, 2023 to be organized on 5 June 2023.

A meeting of the Nodal Officers of the Central Ministries was held under the Chairmanship of DG Forest on 2 May 2023 at 9:45AM virtually from Krishna Conference Hall, Indira Paryavaran Bhawan, New Delhi to discuss coordination activities and 2 LiFE Portals for the celebration of World Environment Day 2023 on 5 June 2023.

- 2. At the outset, Shri Tanmay Kumar, Additional Secretary EF&CC made a presentation and briefed the participants about the pivotal role of the Nodal Officers for the Mass Mobilization Campaign leading up to World Environment Day on 5 June 2023. The presentation also covered a detailed demonstration of the 2 portals designed for WED Meri LiFE Portal and Mission LiFE Portal that will be used by the Nodal Officers for reporting details of the events conducted.
- 3. Key points discussed in the meeting were as follows:
 - Tasks ahead for the appointed Nodal Officers from Ministries/ Departments
 - All Nodal Officers must finalize the LiFE events to be conducted by their ministries/departments before 5 June 2023 and on 5 June 2023.
 - 6 Working out a two-part Plan of Action along with the calendar of events to be undertaken in the run up to World Environment Day and on WED.
 - o Nodal Officers to in turn hold coordination meetings within the Ministry, with all organizations and departments of the Ministry, with the event organizers and nominating Field Officers for each event, with their respective State Counterparts, and associated non-governmental stakeholders.
 - Uploading details of the events conducted on the Meri LiFE Portal by the Nodal
 Officers for each event (https://merilife.org/) with a limit of 5 pictures per
 event with relevant captions, 3 videos of 45 seconds each per event with
 relevant captions, and a short description of each event.
 - Features of the Meri LiFE Portal were demonstrated in detail to the Nodal Officers –
 - Meri LiFE is a portal created specially to capture the details of the Awareness Generation and LiFE Actions of the events conducted in the run up to World Environment Day. It will be used by Nodal Officers/Field Officers to upload details, and pictures and videos of all events as specified and used by Ministry/State Nodal Officers to review their progress.
 - OTP Based Login for each Ministry, Department, Division, and State.
 - Fixed format reports and customizable format reports available for download and review.

- User manual available for Nodal Officers and District Field Officers regarding using the portal with detailed instructions.
- Dedicated helpdesk available to offer support and resolve any issues that may arise with the portal.
- In addition to the helpdesk, a regular VC will be conducted to resolve further issues related to the portal.
- Portal can be accessed from mobile phones as well so that information can be uploaded directly from the field.
- o The Nodal Officers must also download LiFE Creatives, Videos, Logos and Knowledge Material from the Mission LiFE Portal (http://missionlife-moefcc.nic.in/) to be widely disseminated during all events and on Social Media handles of all Ministries.
- Regular reviewing and monitoring of activities to maintain the momentum of the mass mobilization campaign and to ensure adherence to the calendar of events.
- Ministry of Culture requested that Event Reports from both LiFE Portals be aligned with the AKAM portal for efficient reporting through API integration.
