Subject: Reorganization of operation of Assaying & Hallmarking Centers

1. After the implementation of mandatory hallmarking the work load in hallmarking has increased. As desired by DG, BIS, in order to speed up the process of recognition/audits and have close coordination with hallmarking centres, the activities related to handling of files related to AHC and recognition/renewal/ suspension/ /expiry of the AHC may be decentralized from RO level to BO level .
2. Accordingly, the following is informed.
 - a. BO will deal all the files of AHC lying within the territorial jurisdiction of branch office.
 - b. A scientific officer shall be authorized by Head BO to deal with the files of AHC in addition to the certification work handled by him/her.
 - c. In case sufficient number of auditor are not available in branch, BO may utilize the service of auditors in other BO/RO after approval of DDGR.
 - d. The recognition /renewal/non-renewal/deferment/expiry and suspension of the AHC shall be done by Head (BO) and only in cases of cancellation/de-recognition the case shall be forwarded to DDGR who shall be the competent authority for cancellation/de-recognition of AHC.
 - e. The hallmarking agents posted in BOs may also be utilized by the BO for audits of AHC, in addition to the market surveillance of jewelers. For undertaking the audits of AHC necessary training as required as per HMD circular dated HMD/14:44 dated 12/10/2018 may be provided by BO.
3. The above arrangement will come in to effect from 01 January 2022.
