Subject: **National Health Mission - reg.**

This has reference to e-mail dated 13 October 2022 of P&C, HQs forwarded herewith the copy D.O.No. Z-28015/108/2022-TB-Part (2) dated 07th October 2022 of the Shri Rajiv Gauba Cabinet Secretary, Government of India, on the above subject (**copy enclosed**).

2. After perusal the said D.O. dated 07th October 2022 of the Cabinet Secretary, Govt. of India and submitted as follows:

- (i) National Tuberculosis Elimination Programme (NTEP) is being implemented throughout the Country under National Health Mission (NHM) by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW), Govt. of India. Under NTEP, all TB patients, notified both by public and private sector health facilities/doctors, are provided free diagnostics and treatment as well as Rs. 500/month for nutrition support through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT).
- (ii) To facilitate enhanced engagement of the community in achieving the objective of TB elimination by 2025, MoHFW has recently launched 'Pradhan Mantri TB Mukh Bharat Abhiyaan (PMTBMBA)' as a part of NTEP. To ensure its effective implementation, Ni-kshay 2.0, an exclusive web-portal for registration of Ni-kshay Mitra (Donors) and online link up of such Nikshay Mitras with TB patients has been developed. Interested officials of the Bureau can register themselves as Ni-kshay Mitra and select:
 - (a) The area/number of TB patients they are interested to adopt & support;
 - (b) Type of support (Nutritional/Vocational/additional diagnostics); and
 - (c) The duration (minimum duration being 6 months & maximum being 3 years).

3. Keeping in view of above, Head of all ROs/BOs/Labs/NITS including HQs are requested to bring to the notice of their officers/staff, others and to encourage the Officers of your respective offices to participate in this initiative. The interested Officers can register themselves as Ni-kshay Mitra by visiting www.communitysupport.nikshay.in. Ministry of Health & Family Welfare would provide any further assistance required in this regard.
