Subject: Product Manual and guidelines for implementation of Amendment No. 2 to IS 1293: 2019 'Plugs and Socket-Outlets for household and similar purposes of rated Voltage up to and including 250 V and rated current up to and including 16 A'

- 1. The product 'Plugs and socket-outlets' as per IS 1293 : 2019 'Plugs and Socket-Outlets for household and similar purposes of rated Voltage up to and including 250 V and rated current up to and including 16 A' is covered under mandatory certification and as on date there are 489 licence and 3 applications for the product under Scheme –I.
- 2. Amendment No. 2 to IS 1293 : 2019 has been published and the last date of concurrent running of IS 1293 : 2019 with and without Amendment No. 2 is **26 September 2024**.
- 3. All BOs shall inform the Applicants and Licensees under their jurisdiction about the implementation of the amendment within a week of issuance of these guidelines.
- 4. The significant changes in the Indian Standard through the Amendment is listed below for the purpose of general guidance:
  - a. 2P (Sockets) of 6A rating has been added in the Table 2'Tyes and Ratings' of the Indian Standard;
  - b. Provision to use Halogen Free Flame Retardant (HFFR) cables as per IS 17048 for use as flexible/rigid cables has been added in addition to existing cables as per IS 694 and IS 9968 (Part 1).
- 5. In view of the above, the existing Product Manual is revised as 'PM/IS 1293/3/May 2024'. The same can be accessed from BIS website.
- 6. The guidelines for implementation of the Amendment No. 2 to IS 1293 : 2019 is given below:

## A. For Licensees:

- (i) All Licensees shall implement the Amendment by **26 September 2024**. Any difficulty in implementation shall be brought to the notice of CMD III within 30 days of issuance of these guidelines. BOs shall ensure that no Licences are under operation Standard without Amendment after **26 September 2024**. The status of implementation of the Amendment shall be confirmed by Head (BO) to CMD-III within two weeks of the last date of concurrent running.
- (ii) In order to add new variety in the existing scope of licence, provision at Section C 'For Inclusions' to be followed by considering the grouping guidelines prescribed in the Product Manual 'PM/IS 1293/3/May 2024'.
- (iii) In order to implement the provision for use in HFFR cables as per IS 17048 along with plugs/socket-outlets, separate testing is not required as the product is covered under mandatory certification.

(iv) Verification of implementation of the Amendment, shall be done during the next visit which shall be completed within one month from the date of submission of compliance by licensee.

BOs shall ensure that the product conforms to all the requirements, as applicable, as (v) per the amended Standard after the date of implementation. If the Licensee fails to complete all actions by **26 September 2024** it shall be dealt with as per the prevailing

guidelines.

**B. For Applicants:** 

(i) Existing Applications where Sample has been submitted in the Laboratory/Test Report has been issued by the Laboratory may be processed without the Amendment. However,

if the Applicant is desirous of considering the application with Amendment, a declaration may be obtained from the Applicant to that effect and the Application may

be processed accordingly. An undertaking shall also be obtained from such Applicants that if the sample fails while considering the provisions of the Amendment, Licence will

not be granted as without considering the Amendment.

(ii) Applications which are recorded henceforth may be processed with or without

considering the Amendment. Processing of Applications without considering the Amendment shall be permitted only up to 26 September 2024 and for such cases Applicant shall give a declaration that they will implement the Amendment by 26

September 2024.

(iii) Beyond 26 September 2024 no Licence shall be granted without consideration of the

Amendment.

**C. For Inclusions:** 

(i) For change in scope of licence, the relevant provisions as given above for Applicants

shall apply.

(ii) However, processing of such applications for change in scope of licence without

considering the Amendment shall be permitted only upto the date of implementation of

the Amendment by the licensee or up to 26 September 2024 whichever is earlier.

7. The above guidelines come into force with immediate effect.
