- 1. The existing IS 14493 (Part 5): 2018/ IEC 61156-5: 2012 'Multicore and symmetrical pair / quad cables for digital communications: Part 5 symmetrical pair / quad cables with transmission characteristics up to 1000 MHz Horizontal floor wiring Sectional specification' has been revised to IS 14493 (Part 5): 2023/ IEC 61156-5: 2020 'Multicore and symmetrical pair / quad cables for digital communications: Part 5 symmetrical pair / quad cables with transmission characteristics up to 1000 MHz Horizontal floor wiring Sectional specification (First Revision)'.
- 2. The major changes in the revised IS 14493 (Part 5): 2023/ IEC 61156-5 : 2020 with respect to existing IS 14493 (Part 5): 2018/ IEC 61156-5 : 2012 are indicated below:

3. In view of the above changes, the existing Product Manual has been revised as PM/IS 14493

(Part 5)/ IEC 61156-5/2/October 2024. The same can be accessed from BIS website. The manufacturers are required to submit their acceptance to revised scheme of inspection and testing; or submit their own quality assurance plan as per the revised product manual.

4. The guidelines for implementation of the revised Standard are given below:

A. For existing licencees:

- (i) All Licensees shall implement the revised Standard. Any difficulty in implementation shall be brought to the notice of CMD III within 30 days of issuance of these guidelines. BOs shall ensure that no Licences are under operation Standard as per old standard after issuance of the guidelines. The status of implementation of the revised standard shall be confirmed by Head (BO) to CMD-III within two weeks of issuance of the guidelines.
- (ii) In order to establish compliance to the latest Indian Standard, the Licensee manufacturer has to submit in-house/ independent test report as evident to conformity to the applicable clauses of the revised Standard. A suitable undertaking may also be taken for the requirements where compliance is already established and/ or testing is not required.
- (iii) Verification of implementation of the revised standard, to be done during the next visit which shall be completed within one month from the date of submission of compliance by the licensee.

B. For Applicants:

(i) Applications which are recorded henceforth may be processed as per the revised Standard IS 14493 (Part 5): 2023/ IEC 61156-5: 2020.

C. For Inclusions:

- (i) For change in scope of licence, the relevant provisions as given above for Applicants shall apply.
- 5. The above guidelines shall come into force with immediate effect.
