Subject: Applicant samples submission with pre-registration through online portal - reg.

This has reference to the subject matter.

- 2) In this regard, it may be noted that the requirement of pre-registration of applicant samples was introduced in May 2021 for the purposes of Grant of Licence (GoL) and Change in Scope of Licence (CSoL). Samples submitted in third party laboratories prior to introduction of these measures were allowed to be accepted.
- 3) Subsequently, certain queries have been received about applicability of these requirements in scenarios other than for the purpose of GoL and CSoL.
- 4) In this regard, it may kindly be noted that unless otherwise specifically stated in product specific guidelines/circular issued by CMDs (for changeover etc.), the requirement of submission of sample with pre-registration through online portal need not be insisted upon.
- 5) Some of these scenarios, which are not limited to, are:
 - i) Implementation of an amendment or revision of the Indian Standard specifications, where test report from third party laboratory may be necessary.
 - ii) Submission of test report of variety (as prescribed in the product manual) for a product group already endorsed in the licence (like flameproof equipment, distribution transformers etc.)
 - iii) Change of components or raw-materials (like demineralisation and remineralisation in case of packaged drinking water)
 - iv) Implementation of revised product manual and advisory of test report submission by existing licensee from third party laboratory (like wheel rims)
- 6) This issues with the approval of the competent authority.
