Subject: Guidelines for implementation of Revised IS 1374:2024 (Chicken Feed - Specification)

1. IS 1374:2007 has been revised as IS 1374:2024 and has been published. The last date for implementation of the revised Standard is **26 Sept 2024** after which the old Standard shall stand withdrawn.
2. All BOs shall inform the Applicants and Licensees under their jurisdiction about implementation of the revised Standard within a week of issuance of these guidelines.
3. The significant changes in the revised Standard as listed in the Table are given for the purpose of general guidance. BOs shall ensure that the product conforms to all the requirements, as applicable, as per the revised Standard.

Clause No.	Change
Cover page, title, Cl. 1	The title of the standard has been modified from 'Poultry feed' to 'Chicken feed' to bring out clarity on the species for which the requirements are specified in the standard;
3	Types of chicken feeds have been updated in accordance with the existing field practices. Additional varieties i.e. Pre-lay feed for layer, broiler breeder, and layer breeder feeds have been included;
Table 2 , 3	Specified requirements for protein, calcium, phosphorous, metabolizable energy, amino acids and vitamins have been updated;
Table 2, 3	Minimum levels for threonine, sodium, chloride and potassium have been specified in the standard. Test method has been prescribed for testing of the requirement for Methionine + Cysteine;
4.2	Requirement for prohibiting use of antibiotics from medically important antimicrobial classes in feed for growth promotion has been introduced under 4.2 which was earlier a recommendatory provision.

4. Consequent upon the issuance of the revised Standard, the existing product manual has been revised which is being circulated separately through BIS website.
5. The guidelines for implementation of the revised Standard is given below:

A. LICENSEES:

- i. The licensee shall implement the revised Standard by **26 Sept 2024**. Any difficulty in implementation shall be brought to the notice of CMD 2 at the earliest. BOs shall ensure that no Licences are under operation as per the old Standard after **26 Sept 2024**. **The status of implementation of the revised Standard shall be confirmed by Head (BO) to CMD-2 within two weeks of the last date of concurrent running.**
- ii. Since the types of chicken feeds as well the requirements thereof have been modified, the licensees shall submit the revised scope of licence indicating the equivalent types of feed to be covered in their scope as per the revised standard, based on the types covered in the existing scope of licence.

Note: For the purpose of determining equivalence of types, the categorization of feed based on stages i.e. broiler feed, layer feed and broiler breeder feed as well the age of the chickens, shall be considered. Types may be considered equivalent if they are from the same category and the age groups are overlapping as per the existing and revised standard. For example, the existing standard has two types BPSF and BSF meant for use from 1 to 7 and 8 to 21 days, respectively whereas the revised standard has the equivalent types BSF and BGF meant for use from 1 to 10 days and 11 to 21 days, respectively.

- iii. For each of the types of feed as per the revised standard intended to be covered in the scope of the licence, the licensee shall submit evidence of conformity to the additional and modified requirements through In-house/Independent Test Reports as well as revised list of test equipment (as per Form 2). Verification of implementation of the revised Standard, wherever required, **shall be verified through a surveillance visit within 30 days of confirmation of implementation of the revised standard by licensee.**
- iv. If the Licensee fails to complete all actions by **26 Sept 2024** it shall be dealt with as per the prevailing guidelines.

B. APPLICATIONS FOR GRANT OF LICENCE:

- i. Existing Applications where Sample has been submitted in the Laboratory/Test Report has been issued by the Laboratory may be processed as per the old Standard. However, if the Applicant is desirous of considering the Application as per the revised Standard, a declaration may be obtained from the Applicant to that effect and the Application may be processed accordingly. An undertaking shall from such Applicants also be obtained that if the sample fails while considering the provisions of the revised Standard, Licence will not be granted by BIS as per the old version.
- ii. Applications which are recorded henceforth may be processed as per the old Standard or the revised Standard. Processing of Applications as per the old Standard shall be permitted only up to **25 Sept 2024** and for such cases Applicant shall give a declaration that they will implement the revised Standard by **26 Sept 2024**.
- iii. Beyond **26 Sept 2024** no Licence shall be granted as per the old Standard.

C. CHANGE IN SCOPE OF LICENCE:

- i. For change in scope of licence, the relevant provisions as given above for Applicants shall apply.
- ii. However, processing of such applications for change in scope of licence as per the old Standard shall be permitted only up to the date of implementation of the revised Standard or up to **26 Sept 2024** whichever is earlier.

6. The above guidelines come into force with immediate effect.
