Subject: Amendment No.2 to Guidelines on Special Campaign for Sensitization of Gram Panchayats for Utilizing Indian Standards for Government Programme & Schemes

1.Revised guidelines for sensitization of Gram Panchayat presidents and secretaries on significance of implementing standards at village level were circulated vide Doc. No. TNMD/GP/2, Aug 2023 dated 30 Aug 2023 (Pg. 179 to 277). The guideline was mainly focused on small programmes with 60 participants at block levels with support of volunteers of NGOs/COs and RPs operating at grass root level. Subsequently, Amendment no 1 was issued incorporating new clause nos. 6.4 and 6.5 after clause 6.3 to aforementioned guidelines focusing on special campaigns at district levels targeting larger participants.

2. The Clause No. 6.0 regarding Financial Assistance from BIS in the aforementioned guidelines is verbatim as follows:"

6.1 Financial assistance to NGOs/COs for this Special Sensitization Campaign for Gram Panchayats from BIS will be Rs. 100/- per participant (as refreshment to the participants). Also, a grant of Rs. 2000/- per programme shall be provided by BIS to the concerned NGO/CO for meeting the administrative expenses related to venue arrangements, travel expenses of their volunteers, Stationery and audio-visual support, etc.

6.2. The financial assistance mentioned above is for non-residential programme and indicates the maximum amount of financial assistance.

6.3. Maximum no. of participants for each programme shall not exceed 60. The sanctioning authority would record the justification, if the no. of participants exceeds 60. However, in any case, the maximum expenditure would not exceed Rs. 10,000/- per programme

6.4 For special campaigns at district levels, the no. of participants for each programme may be upto 150 with refreshment limit of Rs 300/- per participant subject to the max. budget of 50,000/- for each such programme. However, BOs shall preferably utilize Govt. venues at district level for conducting these programme to the extent possible.

6.5 The above special campaigns would be conducted by scientific officers along with resource personnel. Financial provisions under the Clause 6.4 is only applicable in case of sensitization programme is being conducted at district level as part of special campaigns announced by the Competent Authority.”

3. "In light of feedback received during the ROs/BOs review meeting on November 30, 2023, at NITS Noida, the existing guidelines as outlined in Clause 6.0 has been amended as follows:"

“For non-residential programme BIS will provide financial assistance of Rs. 150/- per participant at the Block/Taluka/Gram etc level and Rs. 300/- per participant at the District level for conducting Sensitization Programmes for Gram Panchayats. Additionally, if the program is conducted by an NGO/CO, BIS will grant Rs. 2000/- per program to cover administrative expenses related to venue arrangements, travel expenses of volunteers, stationery, audio-visual support, etc. Govt. venues may preferably be utilized for conducting these programme, to the extent possible. The maximum number of participants for individual programme shall be as decided by the Head (BO). so as to allow effective dissemination of information during the program.”
