#### **ITEM 0 WELCOME**

- 0.1** Member Secretary extended a warm welcome to the members present in the meeting. Member secretary informed that due to some medical emergency Shri Arvind Kumar, Chairperson LITD 17 is unable to participate in the meeting and he has suggested that Shri A. K Upadhyaya may chair today's meeting. The committee agreed to the suggestion.
- 0.2** Shri A. K Upadhyaya, Chairperson for the meeting extended a warm welcome to the members present in the meeting. He sought active participation of all the participants.

#### **ITEM 1 FORMAL CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF LAST MEETING**

- 1.1** Minutes of the 23rd meeting of 'Information Systems Security and Privacy' Sectional Committee, LITD 17 held on 02 June 2023 were circulated on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2023. No Comments have been received. The committee formally confirmed the minutes.

## **ITEM 3 INTERNATIONAL STANDARDIZATION ACTIVITIES**

**3.1** The committee noted the information as given at item 3.1 of the agenda

### **3.2 Experts Registered in JTC 1/SC 27 and JTC 1/WG 13**

The committee considered the information as given at item 3.2 of the agenda. Member secretary informed that information related to under development documents of JTC 1/SC 27 along with status of participation of experts as available was shared with the registered experts. Experts were requested to confirm the status and to provide an update w.r.t their participation and contributions.

All registered experts were requested to provide during the meeting. Update was provided by Mr. Sanjiv Agarwala, Mr Sanjeev Chhabra, Mr. Srinivas P, Dr. Vishnu Kanhere, Mr. Raakesh T, Dr. Gargi Keeni, Prof Sanjit Chatterjee, Dr Gautham Sekar ,Mr Abhik Chaudhuri, Dr Sarmistha Neogy, Mr Vishal Kumar and Member Secretary.

The committee requested the experts registered to actively participate in their respective working groups and to specifically provide inputs at Working Draft (WD) Stage. The committee deliberated and decided as follows:

- a) Member Secretary would share updated list of under development documents of JTC 1/SC 27 and accordingly each registered expert needs to identify the projects in which he/she would contribute for his/her respective working group. Experts were requested to inform such project within 30 days and in case of no further information by registered expert, the respective expert would be removed from the respective JTC 1/SC 27 WG.
- b) Registered experts shall regularly provide their report of participation to LITD 17.
- c) To approach IIT Roorkee for contributions to JTC 1/SC 27 WG 2

### **3.3 MEETINGS OF ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 27**

#### **3.3.1 37<sup>th</sup> meeting of JTC 1/SC 27 and working group**

The committee noted the information as given at item 3.3.1 of the agenda.

#### **3.3.2 37<sup>th</sup> meeting of JTC 1/SC 27 and working group**

The committee considered the information as given at item 3.3.2 of the agenda.

Member secretary informed that he had participated in the WG meetings (17<sup>th</sup> -21<sup>st</sup> April 2023) of JTC 1/SC 27 in person at USA and plenary meetings (24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> April 2023) were attended virtually. He also informed that all other delegates had participated in the meetings through remote participation mode.

Mr. Sanjiv Agarwala, Mr Sanjeev Chhabra, Mr. Srinivas P, Dr. Vishnu Kanhere, Mr. Raakesh T, Dr Gautham Sekar, Mr Abhik Chaudhuri, Prof Sanjit Chatterjee, and Mr. Kshitij Bathla provided their report of participation in the WG meetings of JTC 1/SC 27. It was also informed that Ms. Reena Garg, Mr. Kshitij Bathla, Mr. Sanjiv Agarwala and Dr. Vishnu Kanhere had participated in the JTC 1/SC 27 Plenary meetings.

During the debriefing specific suggestions were provided related to PWI Security and Privacy of Digital Twin. Suggestions were made that concepts of Digital twin and architecture should be conceptualized before considering security and privacy of Digital Twin. Member Secretary informed that this aspect was discussed during the SC 27/WG meetings as well and there is already work in progress in JTC 1/SC 41. It was also informed that LITD 27 is the National Mirror committee of JTC 1/SC 41 and inputs

related to Digital Twin could be submitted to LITD 27. Only aspects related to Security and Privacy of Digital Twin could be considered in LITD 17.

### **3.3.3 38th meeting of JTC 1/SC 27 and working group**

The committee noted the information as given at item 3.3.3 of the agenda. Member Secretary informed that next plenary meetings of JTC 1/SC 27 are scheduled to be held virtually during 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> October 2023 (05:00 UTC - 09:00 UTC). Member secretary also informed about the modes of meetings [Face to Face, Hybrid, Face to Face with remote participation] available for JTC 1 and its Sub - Committee meetings as mentioned in the JTC 1 SD 19 'Meetings'.

Mr. Srinivas P suggested that meetings should be either only face to face or only virtual because of the challenges with Hybrid meeting until unless there are state of the art system to facilitate Hybrid meetings. He also conveyed that physical meetings are always more effective however considering the recent scenario SC 27 meetings should have Hybrid mode. Mr. Srinivas P suggested that if possible we should push this aspect of meeting modes. Dr. Gargi Keeni informed that JTC 1 SD 19 is recently updated document so there is little possibility of another change in JTC 1 SD 19 unless there is some concrete proposal in terms of better suggestions for JTC 1 SD 19. She suggested that if as National Body we have some suggestions then we can submit to JTC 1.

The committee deliberated and requested members to provide their suggestions related to meeting modes so as to accordingly consider the suggestions for further submission. Dr. Gargi Keeni being CAG member was requested to provide further update related to schedule of October 2023 meeting of JTC 1/SC 27.

**3.4** The committee considered the information as given at item 3.4 of the agenda. Members were requested to consider and inform the standards which may be considered for adoption as Indian Standard.

**3.5** The committee considered the list of standards published by JTC 1/SC 27 and corresponding Indian standards as given in Annex-4 of the agenda. Member secretary informed that lists of standards published by JTC 1/SC 27 and LITD 17 are in public domain and are available on respective websites of ISO and BIS. Member secretary informed that list given in Annex-4 is mapping of both these lists so as to identify the standards which have been adopted or not adopted as Indian Standard. Members appreciated the information given in Annex-4. Members informed that this information would be very useful. Members suggested to explore the feasibility of providing this information on BIS website as well. It was also suggested that against this information; the information related to usage of standards could also be captured.

Further Mr. Narang Kishor suggested regarding mapping of standards of security and privacy w.r.t use cases or specific concerns where these could be utilized. Member Secretary informed that this aspect was discussed in the last meeting as well. The committee deliberated again and It was decided that members interested to volunteer for this work may confirm to the member secretary so that accordingly those members along with Mr. Narang Kishor may provide initial draft proposal of mapping for further discussion in subsequent meetings.

Members were also requested to consider the list and inform the standards which could be considered for adoption as Indian Standards.

**5.6 Adoption of ISO/IEC 18033- 7:2022 ‘Information security — Encryption algorithms — Part 7: Tweakable block ciphers’**

The committee considered the information as given at item 5.6 and it was decided to circulate ISO/IEC 18033-7:2022 as draft Indian Standard in wide circulation for a period of two months.

It was also decided to circulate deliberations held related to ISO/IEC FDIS 18033-7 along with wide circulation of ISO/IEC 18033-7:2022.

**5.7 Adoption of ISO/IEC 27559:2022 ‘Information security, cybersecurity and privacy protection – Privacy enhancing data de-identification framework’**
