ITEM 0 WELCOME

0.1 Member Secretary, Shri Priyanshu Sharma welcomed the participants to the meeting.

0.2 Shri Mahesh D Kulkarni, Chairperson, formally welcomed the participants to the meeting for deep diving into the picture, audio, video standards which are very important. He emphasized on the role of AI in all standards especially audio & video and its role in enhancing coding, interactive audio & videos which are upcoming today's requirement.

He also apprised the members of the need of protections of audio video from deep fake creations which makes the role of this committee even more crucial. He further requested the members to provide their valuable inputs and support in this committee's initiatives and requested the Member Secretary to take up the formal agenda items.

After a brief introduction of the members present, the Member Secretary took upon the formal agenda items.

ITEM 5 GUIDELINES FOR RESEARCH & DEVELOPMENT (R&D) PROJECTS FOR THE FORMULATION AND REVIEW OF STANDARDS INVITING POTENTIAL R&D PROJECTS FROM THE COMMITTEE MEMBERS

Member secretary apprised the members of the recent BIS initiative to support research supporting standards wherein guidelines were issued for research & development (R&D) projects for the formulation and review of standards inviting potential (R&D) projects from the committee members along with the ToR template and the action required from the committee members. He further explained the guidelines to the committee.

Member Secretary encouraged the committee members to share proposals on potential R&D projects with the BIS Secretariat for the committee's consideration since this is an ongoing continuous exercise.

Member Secretary informed the committee that based on the projects by the screening committee, BIS will subsequently publish a list of R&D projects, along with the associated Terms of Reference (ToR) on Standardization portal or any other suitable digital platform.

Dr. Manish Gupta, DA-IICT Gandhinagar gave a detailed presentation on the potential R&D project on "JPEG DNA Exploration". The committee highly appreciated the idea behind the proposal, provided minor editorial suggestions regarding the scope and **approved** the modified ToR of the R&D project, subject to the condition no other comments are received by the BIS secretariat by 22 November 2023.

After the presentation, representative of CDAC informed the committee of CDAC also working in this area and they may like to contribute to the project in the future.

ITEM 9 ANY OTHER BUSINESS

9.1 Various suggestions were received during the meeting regarding the active progress of work by this committee in formulating the relevant standards:

- To explore the possibility of involvement of students in the committee related work and the mapping of published standards with their course curriculum, including some possible lectures dedicated on Standards for the students community. Member Secretary clarified BIS has been conducting guest lectures in various institutes and apprise the committee of the institutions BIS has an MoU with.
- The committee may prepare a list of DPITT recognized startups relevant to the scope of LITD-23, and we should involve them in the standardization process.
- Various departments of the Govt. of India such as DST, MEITY (Two projects already approved for codes) are giving out research grants/projects to multiple companies/startups, with many relevant to the committee's scope. Efforts should be made to follow up with the concerned departments regarding the possibility of these funded research resulting in potential standards relevant to LITD-23.
