ITEM 0 WELCOME

- **0.1** Mr. Kshitij Bathla, Member Secretary, LITD 30 welcomed all the participants.
- 0.2 Dr. Pushpak Bhattacharyya, Chairperson LITD 30 welcomed all the participants. He wished new year to all the participants. He informed that yesterday's budget speech of Finance Minister has emphasised the importance of Artificial Intelligence and the vision is "Make AI in India and Make AI work for India". He also expressed that committee's work has become more relevant and we should proactively formulate standards in this area. He requested all members to diligently review all documents and to provide their inputs.

ITEM 1 FORMAL CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF LAST MEETINGS

1.1. Member Secretary informed that the minutes of the twenty fifth meeting of the Artificial Intelligence sectional committee held on 08 September 2022 and of twenty sixth meeting held on 02 November 2022 were circulated on 6 December 2022 and no comments have been received. The committee formally confirmed the minutes.

ITEM 2 SCOPE AND COMPOSITION OF SECTIONAL COMMITTEE LITD 30

- **2.1** The committee noted the following scope of the committee: "Standardization in the area of Artificial Intelligence and Big Data" Liaison: ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 42 "Artificial Intelligence"
- **2.2** The Committee considered the composition of "Artificial Intelligence, Sectional Committee LITD 30" and its panel/working groups as given at item 2.2 of the agenda. Member Secretary informed that nominations have been received from National Informatics Center (NIC); Information Technology, Electronics and Communication Department, Government of

Telangana & Nomination is awaited from Department of Science and Technology (DST). The committee decided to again approach Department of Science and Technology (DST). Member Secretary also informed that organizations whose participation is 0/3 were approached and response has been received from Philips and Wadhwani Institute of Artificial Intelligence.

The committee decided that organizations who have neither participated regularly in three meetings nor contributed by way of commenting on any of the documents would be once again requested to consider active participation in the committee work. The committee also decided that in case of no response from such organizations, the organizations would be recommended for withdrawal in consultation with the chairperson LITD 30.

Member Secretary also informed that some co-option requests have been received through BIS standardization portal and same would be shared with the committee for further decision. Updated composition along with participation status is given in **Annex-2**.

ITEM 3 INTERNATIONAL STANDARDIZATION ACTIVITIES

3.1 The committee noted the information as given at item 3.1 of the agenda.

3.2 INDIA'S PROPOSALS TO JTC 1/SC 42

3.2.1 Proposals under discussion

A. Proposal -Levels of specifications for AI systems

The committee considered the information as given at item 3.2.1 A) of the agenda. Dr. Nisheeth Srivastava provided quick background of the proposal. Dr. Nisheeth Srivastava informed that from the discussions in SC 42/WG 3 and LITD 30/Panel 3, it has emerged that our proposal can be described as the proposal for need of assurance/need to avoid harm/need to avoid bad outcomes. This could be described as levels of Assurance/Trustworthiness. The AI system that we really want to be sure about that it would not do anything bad or unexpected have to have higher levels of Assurance/Trustworthiness and other AI systems can have low levels of Assurance/Trustworthiness. He informed that we are planning to rename the proposal to "levels of Assurance/Trustworthiness". Further regarding criteria of determination of the levels of Assurance/Trustworthiness, we plan to do this through use case/case study as per the revised proposal.

Mr. Gautam Banerjee informed that this was discussed on 27th Jan 2023 meeting of LITD 30/Panel 3 and it had emerged that the proposal could be described as an aspiration model to which product can aspire to achieve.

Member Secretary informed that after meeting on 27th Jan 2023, inputs were provided by Ms. Chitra (DRDO) and the inputs have been forward to LITD 30 and its all groups.

Dr. Nisheeth Srivastava informed that he would initiate the task of revision of the proposal and would share the document for inputs of the LITD 30 members before further submission to SC 42/WG 3 for discussion in 16th Feb 2023 meeting.

It was decided that based on the inputs and discussions held, proposal would be revised for further discussion in SC 42/WG 3 and efforts should be to get recommendation of SC 42/WG 3 for launch of NP ballot by April 2023 meetings of JTC 1/SC 42.

B. Proposal -Reliability of AI Systems

The committee noted the information as given at item 3.2.1 B) of the agenda and decided to discuss in next meeting.

3.2.2 Status of India's approved proposals to JTC 1/SC 42

a) The committee noted the information as given at item 3.2.2 a) of the agenda. The committee appreciated the efforts of Mr. Gautam Banerjee, project leader of ISO/IEC 24668:2022 and the team of experts who specifically contributed along with Mr. Gautam Banerjee during the development of this standard.

Member Secretary suggested to plan a webinar to promote ISO/IEC 24668:2022 and other under development standards. The committee agreed to the suggestion and decided to tentatively hold webinar in the first/second week of June 2023 and decided to finalize other details in due course. Members were requested to provide suggestion regarding structure of proposed webinar.

b) The committee noted the information as given at item 3.2.2 b) of the agenda.

c) Verification and Validation Analysis of AI Systems

The committee noted the information as given at item 3.2.2 c) of the agenda. Member secretary informed that SC 42 has informed that multiple nominations have been received by them in response to call for project editor of ISO/IEC AWI TS 17847 'Verification and validation analysis of AI systems'.

Member secretary informed that a meeting with SC 42 leadership is being planned to discuss further steps and accordingly further update would be shared with the committee.

3.3 DOCUMENTS of JTC 1/SC 42

3.3.1 The committee considered the information as given at item 3.3.1. Member Secretary informed that LITD 30/WG 1, LITD 30/WG 2, LITD 30/WG 4 are planning meeting to discuss following documents:

The committee briefly discussed the documents and decided that based on the recommendation of LITD 30/WG 1, LITD 30/WG 2 and LITD 30/WG 4 India's inputs would be submitted to JTC 1/SC 42.

Member Secretary also informed that earlier at CD ballot we need to vote approval/disapproval/abstention along with comments as appropriate however now CD ballot is only for consultation and only comments need to be submitted.

Further Mr. Gautam Banerjee informed about the ballot to approve David Boyd as JTC 1/SC 42 WG 2 Convener and suggested that we could vote in favour. The committee considered and decided to vote in favour.

3.4 Member Secretary informed that all experts were requested to provide update regarding their participation in the respective groups by 27th January 2023. It was informed that each registered expert need to identify the projects in which they would contribute for their respective working group and regular report of participation shall be provided to LITD 30.

The committee considered the list of experts registered in the Sub-groups (working groups, Ahg etc.) of JTC 1/SC 42 as given in Annex-5 of the agenda. Member Secretary suggested that he could share the list of under development standards along with present status and list of experts contributing to the projects.

The committee decided that all registered experts shall inform the projects in which expert is already contributing/intend to contribute at the earliest. It was also decided that in case of no response from the registered experts by 15th June 2023, the non-participating experts and experts who are not providing regular updates would be removed from the respective working group of JTC 1/SC 42.

Representatives of Information Technology, Electronics and Communication Department, Government of Telangana conveyed their interest to contribute to working group 4 of JTC 1/SC 42. The committee decided that new representatives should consider the list of under development standards and accordingly they may inform the working group (along with the project of the working group) to which they would contribute. The committee decided that member secretary should register such new members in the respective group of JTC 1/SC 42 as expert. It was also decided to register member secretary as document monitor in SC 42/AHG 7 'JTC1 joint development review'.

3.5 SC 42 Published Standards

- a) The committee noted the information as given at item 3.5 a) of the agenda.
- b) The committee considered the information as given at item 3.5 b) of the agenda. The committee decided that ISO/IEC TS 4213:2022 Information technology Artificial intelligence Assessment of machine learning classification performance would be shared with the committee for 15 days. Members should examine whether we should adopt ISO/IEC TS 4213:2022 as Indian standard or not. The committee decided that based on the inputs of the members, the decision to adopt ISO/IEC TS 4213:2022 would be taken in consultation with the Chairperson LITD 30.

The committee noted the information as given at item 3.6.1 of the agenda.

The committee considered the information as given at item 3.6.2 of the agenda. Member secretary informed that he has received more confirmation after issuance of agenda of LITD 30 meeting. It was decided to issue these documents again in wide circulation along with final defect reports of ISO/IEC 22989, ISO/IEC 23053.

- 11.2 Mr. Gautam Banerjee and Dr. Pushpak Bhattacharyya suggested to consider proposals regarding estimation frameworks for AI Products, standardization for hyperparameter for neural networks. The committee deliberated that based on further details regarding these ideas the committee may consider in subsequent meetings.
- 11.3 There being no other business to be discussed, meeting ended with vote of thanks to chairperson and all the participants.
