GUAR GUM, FOOD GRADE - SPECIFICATION

1 SCOPE

This standard prescribes the requirements and methods of sampling and test for guar gum, food grade, obtained by grinding the endosperm of *Cyamopsis tetragonolobus* (Linn) Taub, (Fam, Leguminosae ).
