SPECIFICATION FOR BREWER'S YEAST

I. SCOPE

1.1 This standard prescribes the requirements and method of sampling and test for brewer's yeast.

FOREWORD

0.1 This Indian Standard was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 30 December 1983, after the draft finalized by the Bakery and Confectionery Industry Sectional Committee had been approved by the Agricultural and Food Products Division Council.

0.2 Brewer's yeast is used in brewing to ferment the malt and hops into beer. It is also used in pharmaceutical preparations as a substitute for Vitamin B complex preparations, Vitamin D and proteins. This Indian Standard is being formulated to ensure availability of brewer's yeast for the latter purpose.

0.3 The yeast utilized in breweries today are carefully selected and adopted strains of mainly three species *Saccharomyces cerevisiae* Meyenemend Hansen, *Saccharomyces carlsbergensis* Hansen and *Saccharomyces monacensis* Hansen.
