FOREWORD

- **0.1** This Indian Standard was adopted by the Bureau of Indian Standards oil 30 May 1988, after the draft finalized by the Oils and Oilseeds Sectional Committee has been approved by the Chemical Division Council and Agricultural and Food Products Division Council.
- **0.2** Margarine is a semi-solid food product or plastic consistency and is utilized for table use as well as baking and cooking medium. It resembles table (creamery) butter in consistency and appearance. The increase in production and consumption of bakery products and the shortage of table butter has led to the development of margarine industry in this country.

1. SCOPE

1.1 This standard prescribes the requirements and the methods of sampling and test for margarine.
