Textiles — Plain Knitted, Ladies', Cotton Panties — Specification

(First Revision)

1 SCOPE

1.1 This standard prescribes the requirements of plain knitted, ladies' cotton panties, bleached, dyed or printed.

1.2 This standard does not specify general appearance, feel, lustre, degree of whiteness, shade, colour or print design of pantie (*see also 5.3*).
