SULPHITED FATLIQUORS FOR LEATHER — SPECIFICATION

(First Revision)

1 SCOPE

1.1 This standard prescribes requirements, methods of sampling and test for sulphited fatliquors used in the leather industry for fatliquoring.

1.2 This standard covers only sulphited fatliquors made from sulphited oils of marine and vegetable origin inclusive of any additives or blends of fatliquors made thereof.
