PART 8 USE

1.1 Scope

This part of ISO 6196 in intended to facilitate international communication in micrographics. It presents, in two languages, definitions of selected concepts used in micrographics and identifies relationships between the entries.

In order to facilitate their translation into other languages, the definitions are drafted so as to avoid, as far as possible, and peculiarity attached to a language.
