# ROAD VEHICLES — LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS (LPG) SPECIFIC EQUIPMENT — FUEL RAIL

### **1 SCOPE**

**1.1** This standard specifies definitions, general design requirements, performance and test methods of fuel rail of LPG specific equipment of motor vehicles of category L, M and N as defined in IS 14272 : 2011 'Automotive vehicles — Types — Terminology' using LPG in their propulsion system.

**1.2** This standard is applicable to LPG specific equipment intended to use on vehicles using liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) in accordance with Central Motor Vehicle Rules.

**1.3** This standard is not applicable to the LPG specific equipment used in agricultural tractors and construction equipment vehicles.
