FOREWORD

- **0.1** This Indian Standard was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 9 October 1960, after the draft finalized by the Pest Control Products Sectional Committee had been approved by the Agricultural and Food Products Division Council and the Chemical Division Council.
- **0.2** Cuprous oxide dusting powders containing varying percentages of cuprous oxide, technical, are largely used as fungicides for the control of plant diseases in agriculture and horticulture.
- **0.3** Taking into consideration the views of producers, consumers, testing authorities and technologists, the Sectional Committee responsible for the preparation of this standard felt that it should be related to the manufacturing and trade practices followed in the country in this field.
