**TEXTILES – RING SPUN GREY COTTON YARN FOR
WEAVING — SPECIFICATION
(Fourth Revision)**

1 SCOPE

1.1 This standard specifies requirements of ring spun (single and doubled) grey cotton yarn for use in weaving. Cotton yarn intended for use in handloom weaving has been classified separately.

1.2 This standard does not cover yarn produced from blends of cotton with regenerated cellu-losic fibres or any other fibre.
