It is applicable to all types and sizes of organizations involved in emergency preparation, response and recovery activities, such as local, regional and national governments; statutory bodies; international and non-governmental organizations; businesses; and public and community groups.</p> <p>The focus of this document is on vulnerable individuals and their needs in relation to an emergency.</p>
