MYROBALAN EXTRACT — SPECIFICATION

(Second Revision)

1 SCOPE

This standard prescribes the requirements and the methods of sampling and test for myrobalan extract which is largely used for tanning and for treatment of locomotive feed waters and as an admixture to concrete used in oil drilling operations.
