METHODS OF SAMPLING AND TEST
FOR PROCESSED FRUITS AND VEGETABLES

FOREWORD

0.1 This Indian Standard was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 19 September 1964, after the draft finalized by the Fruits and Vegetables Sectional Committee had been approved by the Agricultural and Food Products Division Council.

0.2 Different methods of analysis are at present being followed in different laboratories for testing the processed fruits and vegetables. Owing to differences in the methods employed, there have been often differences of opinion about the quality of the consignments. With the adoption of the methods prescribed in this standard, it is expected that differences in the results due to adoption of different methods in different laboratories will be reduced.

0.3 In reporting the result of a test or analysis made in accordance with this standard, if the final value, observed or calculated, is to be rounded off, it shall be done in accordance with IS : 2-1960*.

1. SCOPE

1.1 This standard prescribes the methods of sampling and test for processed fruits and vegetables.
