**SAFETY OF HOUSEHOLD AND SIMILAR
ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES**

PART 2 PARTICULAR REQUIREMENTS

Section 32 Massage Appliances

1 SCOPE

This clause of IS 302-1 (1979) is applicable except as follows:

1.1 Replacement

This standard applies to electrical appliances primarily intended for massage purposes and for use under household and similar conditions, their rated voltage not exceeding 250 V, ac single phase or dc.

Appliances not intended for normal household use but which nevertheless may be a source of danger to the public, such as appliances intended to be used by lay men in places other than the home are within the scope of this standard.

Appliances intended primarily for purposes other than massage, but which have accessories for massage purposes are within the scope of the standard covering the primary function.

This standard does not take into account the special hazards which exist in nurseries and other places where there are young children or aged or infirm persons without supervision; in such cases additional requirements may be necessary.
