SAFETY OF HOUSEHOLD AND SIMILAR ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES

PART 2 PARTICULAR REQUIREMENTS

Section 59 Insect Killers

1 SCOPE

This clause of IS 302-1 (1979) is applicable except as follows:

1.1 Replacement

This standard applies to safety of electric insect killers for household and similar purposes,

NOTES

1 This standard does not take into account the special hazards which exist in use of this appliance by young children or aged or infirmed persons without supervision. In such cases, additional requirements may be necessary.

2 This standard does not apply to:

- insect killers which function by emitting vaporized chemicals; and
- insect killers intended to be used in locations where special conditions prevail, such as the presence of a corrosive or explosive atmosphere (dust, vapour or gas).

3 For insect killers provided with discharge or tungsten filament lamps IS 10322 (Part 5/Sec 1) also applies.
