SPECIFICATION FOR
GRAM *CHUNI*

0. FOREWORD

0.1 This Indian Standard was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 8 July 1965, after the draft finalized by the Animal Feeds Sectional Committee had been approved by the Agricultural and Food Products Division Council.

0.2 Gram *CHUNI* is a common livestock feed in India. The formulation of this standard was undertaken by the Animal Feeds Sectional Committee in accordance with its programme planned for the formulation of Indian Standards for the various livestock feeds used in this country.

0.3 This standard contains a clause (*see 3.1*) which calls for an agreement between the purchaser and the vendor at the time of placing orders.

0.4 This edition 1.1 incorporates Amendment No. 1 (October 1995). Side bar indicates modification of the text as the result of incorporation of the amendment.

0.5 For the purpose of deciding whether a particular requirement of this standard is complied with, the final value, observed or calculated, expressing the result of a test or analysis, shall be rounded off in accordance with IS : 2-1960*. The number of significant places retained in the rounded off value should be the same as that of the specified value in this standard.

1. SCOPE

1.1 The standard prescribes the requirements and the methods of test for gram (*Cicer arietinum L.*) *CHUNI* for use as livestock feed.
