Indian Standard SPECIFICATION FOR DIMETHOATE, TECHNICAL

FOREWORD

- **0.1** This Indian Standard (First Revision) was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 28 January 1975, after the draft finalized by the Pest Control Sectional Committee had been approved by the Agricultural and Food Products Division Council and the Chemical Division Council.
- **0.2** This standard was first issued in 1966. In this standard the requirements were based on the material which was being imported into the country. With production of dimethoate, technical having been commenced in the country, the technical committee responsible for the formulation of this specification decided to issue this revision. Accordingly, in this revision, requirements for various characteristic have been reviewed in the light of experience gained in the country. Requirements for active ingredient content and acidity have been modified.

1. SCOPE

1.1 This Standard prescribes the requirements and the methods of sampling and test for dimethoate, technical, employed in the preparation of insecticidal formulations.
