*Indian Standard***DEHYDRATED ONION — SPECIFICATION****1 SCOPE**

This standard prescribes the requirements and methods of test and sampling for dehydrated onions, that is, onions from which the bulk of moisture has been removed by dehydration under controlled conditions. It applies to various commercial forms, such as kibbled onion, minced onion, onion grits, onion powder, and onion sings and slices.
