SPECIFICATION FOR EGG POWDER

(First Revision)

FOREWORD

0.1 This Indian Standard (First Revision) was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 16 October 1978, after the draft finalized by the Meat Industry Sectional Committee had been approved by the Agricultural and Food Products Division Council.

0.2 The demand for egg powder is increasing considerably both from the civilian population and from the defence personnel. Moreover, the technological details pertaining to its manufacture have been worked out fully at the Central Food Technological Research Institute, Mysore. This standard is being formulated in order to ensure that the production of egg powder is up to a quality level that is acceptable to the consumers and feasible for the manufactures.

1. SCOPE

1.1 This standard prescribes the requirements and the methods of sampling and test for egg powder.
