## 1 SCOPE

**1.1** This standard prescribes the methods of test for vegetable tanning materials of all kinds and their extracts.

**1.2** This standard covers methods of test for the determination of moisture, total solid, total solubles, non-tannins, tannins, insoluble, pH colour, iron, copper and pentachloro phenol (PCP) content of tanning materials and their extracts.
