SPECIFICATION FOR
DDT WATER DISPERSIBLE POWDER
CONCENTRATES

1. SCOPE

1.1 This standard prescribes the requirements and the methods of sampling and test for DDT water dispersible powder concentrates.

FOREWORD

0.1 This Indian Standard (Third Revision) was adopted by the Indian standard Institution on 29 June 1984. after the draft finalized by the Pest Control Sectional Committee had been approved by the Agricultural and Food Products Division Council and the Chemical Division Council.

0.2 This standard was first issued in 1955. Subsequently, its third revision was issued in 1961, when besides specifying metric values for the requirements for various characteristics, a modified scheme for sampling and methods of test for certain characteristics were Included. Since first revision, Indian industry had gained considerable experience in formulation DDT water dispersible powder concentrate. The technical committee. Responsible for the formulation of this standard, therefore, decided to revise the existing specification to update its requirements. Accordingly, in the second revision requirements for the various characteristics had been reviewed and verified. Besides, all the six amendments issued earlier were also incorporated. In this revision requirements are again being updated. Four amendments issued to second revision have also been incorporated.
