**0. FOREWORD**

**0.1** This Indian Standard ( Part VII ) was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 26 September 1977, after the draft finalized by the Live Animals Sectional Committee had been approved by the Agricultural and Food Products Division Council.

**0.2** Laboratory animals bred and maintained scientifically are necessary to get comparable results in biological experiments. The present code, therefore, lays down guidelines for breeding, care, management and housing of laboratory frogs so that a large number of animals of uniform quality is available. It is hoped that the code would streamline and step up facilities for pharmaceutical, pesticide and biologically-oriented research.

**0.3** For the purpose of deciding whether a particular requirement of this standard is complied ~with, the final value, observed or calculated, expressing the result of a test, shall be rounded off in accordance with IS : 2-1960\*. The number of significant places retained in the rounded off value should be the same as that of the specified value in this standard.

**1. SCOPE**

**1.1** This code ( Part VII ) prescribes conditions for housing, sanitation, personnel hygiene, feeding, watering, disease 'control, etc, in relation to : care, breeding and management of the common Indian frog ( *Rana, tigrina* ).
