**SPECIFICATION FOR
POULTRY EGG FERTILITY TESTER**

FOREWORD

0.1 This Indian Standard was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 6 August 1971, after the draft finalized by the Animal Housing and Equipment Sectional Committee had been approved by the Agricultural and Food Products Division Council.

0.2 Fertile and sound eggs ensure the best hatches and proper utilization of incubation space. Fertility tester shall test the fertility of the eggs during incubation.

0.3 As there are various types and sizes of egg fertility testers in vogue and their performance differs in most of the cases, this standard has been prepared to have an effective quality control and help achieve uniform performance. This standard would also help those who are engaged in the study of embryonic development of eggs at universities, colleges and laboratories.

0.4 This standard contains clause 6.2 which calls for all agreement between the purchaser and the vendor,

0.5 For the purpose of deciding whether a particular requirement this standard is complied with, the final value, observed or calculated, expressing the result of a test, shall be rounded off in accordance with IS : 2-1960*. The number of significant places retained in the rounded off value should be the same as that of the specified value in this standard.

1. SCOPE

1.1 This standard prescribes the requirements and performance test for poultry egg fertility testers.
