CODE FOR HYGIENIC CONDITIONS FOR FRUIT AND VEGETABLE CANNING UNITS

FOREWORD

0.1 This Indian Standard was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 28 April 1972, after the draft finalized by the Food Hygiene, Sampling and Analysis Sectional Committee had been approved by the Agricultural and Food Products Division Council

0.2 Consumers do not have the available knowledge or means of determining the hygienic quality of the food they purchase. For this, they rely on the hygienic standards of various industries that prepare and handle foods. Unless the factory producing the food is governed by a strict hygienic code in respect of layout, plant and personnel, the quality of food produced cannot be considered as safe. These factors have been taken into consideration in the preparation of this code.

1. SCOPE

1.1 This code specifies the hygienic conditions required for establishing and maintaining fruit and vegetable canning units.
