# CONVENTIONAL SIGNS FOR USE ON GENERAL ARRANGEMENT AND DETAIL PLANS OF SHIPS

#### 0. FOREWORD

- **0.1** This Indian Standard was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 7 November 1972, after the draft finalized by the Shipbuilding Sectional Committee had been approved by the Marine, Cargo Movement and Packaging Division Council.
- **0.2** Conventional signs and symbols are widely used in schematic diagrams to indicate various items of equipment and fittings on general arrangement plans of ships.
- **0.3** The signs and symbols used in this standard are in agreement with those given in ISO/R 1964-1971 'Indications of details on the general arrangement plans of ships', issued by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO).

#### 1. SCOPE

**1.1** This standard recommends conventional signs and symbols for indications on general arrangement plans of ships.
